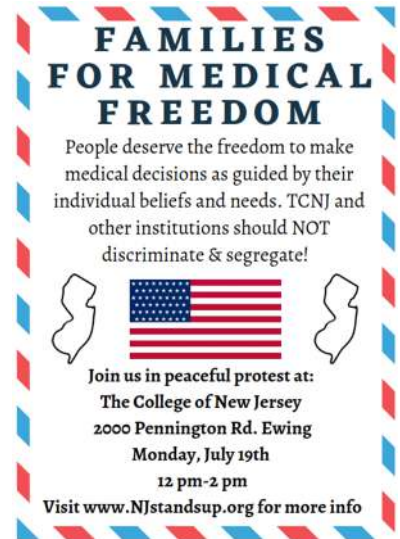

Families for Medical Freedom, in collaboration with NJStandsUp, invites students and citizens of all ages and their families to Rally for Repeal of The College of New Jersey's COVID Vaccine Mandate.



Ewing, NJ - The College of New Jersey, a state school with over 7,000 students on its Ewing campus, has mandated the experimental Emergency Use Authorization coronavirus vaccine for all students. Students are being faced with a decision they never should be burdened with to access their education. Many students are therefore saying "NO" to the mandate.

On Monday, July 19, from 12:00 noon until 2:00pm, TCNJ families and supporters of medical freedom and informed consent will peacefully Stand Up to repeal the vaccine mandate and defend their power of choice. The rally will be held at 2000 Pennington Road, Ewing, New Jersey - near the main entrance - to support liberty and demand revision of this policy.

Families for Medical Freedom will not accept this unconstitutional medical mandate that discriminates and segregates students. Even if a student is able to get a COVID shot exemption, this student will not be allowed to live on campus, will have extra mask requirements and will be regularly swabbed for covid-19. Additionally, TCNJ states these student will have requirements and limitations which include "other things." These students are being ostracized and banned from many school activities. We will not accept mandatory medical procedures as a requirement to go to school and participate in campus life. These students deserve the same Freedom of Choice as TCNJ staff.

This July 19 rally is a Call to Action for everyone WANTING CHOICE in whether to receive the vaccine or not. All citizens are invited to assemble in Ewing, NJ in order to learn about their rights to medical freedom. All who want to uphold health freedom as protected by the US Constitution are asked to support this effort. Together we are unifying to say "NO" to medical mandates.
