Lake Lure National Geographic listed Lake Lure as one of the top 10 most beautiful man-made lakes in the world. This scenic area was the stage for "Dirty Dancing" and "The Last of the Mohicans." And, although Lake Lure seems remote, it's just 40 minutes from the shopping, entertainment, and art scene of Asheville. Lake Lure is located in the "isothermal belt" of North Carolina, an area nestled between the Piedmont hills and the Blue Ridge Mountains famous for warmer winters and cooler summers. Swimming beaches and marinas can be found along Lake Lure's 27-mile shoreline, and lake property surrounding its 720 acres is a draw for those looking to retire or relocate to the Southeast.

Hendersonville This vibrant town is known as the "City of Four Seasons." It is a charming, 2,200-foot elevation mountain community steeped in history and cradled by the Blue Ridge Mountains. With a population of 13,000, it is a quarter the size of its northern neighbor Asheville. The area has a healthy economic base and attracts visitors to its plentiful outdoor recreational opportunities (such as hiking, golf, fishing and horseback riding) and numerous cultural events.
