all aboard KOPEK, if he had more than 1 run this season hed be odds on. Steel Ally to pick up the pieces.Lulamba is a 5yr old and you have to be a really really good 5year old over 2 miles. I think Lulamba wants further so it's a lay for me.
Both of these look to have been put away for this. Never thought id be backing a Mark Walsh runner at Cheltenham, but here we are.
Iroko the class act here, always back a graded horse in a handicap as your uncle Doco says. Blaze the way won at Cheltenham in December over nearly the same Course and distance and beat a decent horse that day. Im sure if he wasn't an Irish horse hed be shorter just because the Irish havent won this race since 2006
Lossiemouth goes here now so that will be the win bet. Golden Ace give us some winner last year although we wont get near that 40/1 again. Very poor renewal if you ask me and Golden Ace is the defending champion so knows how to do it and if anything goes wrong in front like last year ill be golden Ace who picks teh pieces up.
Madar looks so obvious as the plot job so maybe best to just go with that and if Frank Hickey says jungle boogie is over priced each way who am I to argue. One of my least fav races
Both of these have course form back in the Autumn and interestingly Sean Bowen rode both horses then. Back came 2nd in Oct while Wade out won in November. Both probably have this as their target and should give us a good run. Be good to see Sean Bowen get a festival winner.

If Ballyfad had run in the supreme id have had a few quid on him, ran really well all season and id expect him to be there or thereabouts here. Sober is a flat horse and with the last hurdle being moved further away from the line should make an interesting run in.
Final demand was all the rage for this til he ran a stinker at the DRF so im going with Wendigo and Kitzbuehl who won the big novice racing on Boxing day at Kempton, with Wendigo in behind. This isnt Kempton though.
The market has unfortunately found these 2 horses now. Both should give their running but wont be big bets for me
FDC has been my cliff horse for the last few yer always at big odds, (you should have read the blog) Going to guess that Pied Piper is the 2nd pick of elliot as Sam Ewing will probably take the ride. 25/1 seems quite big for a decent enough horse who ran here a few months ago.
If Majborough jumps well hesould win this but he does throw in a few stinkets. Quilxious ran well last year and this has been his only target this season. Boom or Bust.
Jazzy Matty loves the cheltenham festival nearly as much as me. Hes won the last twice and looks only 11b highre so this will have been his target all season for the hatrick. Jack Kennedy on ROD is a good thing.
Gigginstown never usually run horses in this champion bumper but have a good one here. Skelton got MTC from France and hasn't been seen here yet but looks to be a bit of money coming for him into 14s, not a big betting race but a few quid each way for me.

I hate this race ever since Brighterdays got turned over a few yers back. Still gives me the dry boke. Bit of a favorites graveyard this race but Bambino Fever seems to be one of the mullins hotpots this year. I always think this is aslowly run and turns into a 2 furlong sprint which can throw up all sorts of prices.
The regents stroll should take all thebeating here and meetmebythesea has been the talking horse of all the Irish previews
My fav mare since Honeysuckle.If you read my blog from the Elliot yard visit a few years back it was all about Woodhooh, Brighterdays ahead and Favori do Champdou, not bad horses at all over the last couple of years.
If you've looked at previous spreadsheets youll know my feelings on 3m hurdle races. Worst race of the lot. Teahupoo has figures of 212 in tis and could well turn up and regain it. Probably will. Honestly Policy if I must bet. Ma shantou ew if I have too

Mason finished 2nd to Ma Shantou here in October and hes away to the stayers so might be that Mason is very decent horse. Letos each way for the craic.
waterford whispers has been the talking horse for thisifro while. Me interesting to me is Farrive De L'est. If he turns up here will be a decent bet for me but he may hold off until Saturday for the Uttrexter national which hes fav for. If he does have what you like on him.

another race yet another JP fav. Not dying about the jockey booking of JPs these days. If the Macho Man wins ill be saying OHH YEAHH and hopefully Conti follows him up the hill.
Mullins will have a big say here but Skelton in the county always will have a chance. Joyeuse ran well for a long while last year in the mares behind Lossiemouth this is shorter so hopefully will run a big race.
been on Spindleberry for while, Dinoblue goes off fav as yet another JP fav. YAWN, JDG 100% over fences, no idea if that's good enough but well see.
not a fan of favs in this race and cant make my mind up on DR Steinberg. Thedeviluno looked good at Doncaster in jan after finishing 2nd to the DR at Navan. King Bucks will hopefully run a decent race, hoping hes Darraghs pick.
