
יהוה fulfilled His promises through the True Messiah Yahushua



אביה Jesus Christ represents *The Spirit of the Antichrist* (False Messiah) as it was in the "image of a man who died" in whom The Law of יהוה was abolished. The True

Messiah Yahushua declared he did NOT abolish The Torah. In fact, the example he set on this Earth was that of a Torah Obedient Jewish

Rabbi. As the chosen Messiah, Yahushua was sent by יהוה to bring The Torah to its fullest meaning and expression spiritually, that is what fulfil means. It does not mean "abolish".

Mattithvahu/Matthew 5

17 "Do not think that I [*Yeshua*] came to destroy the Torah or the Prophets. I did not come to destroy but to complete. [*Yahushua came to show us how to keep the Torah - he was/is our example. 'Come follow me''.* The Law and the Prophets is a term used for the pre-Messianic Scriptures/Tanakh]

The Torah was given to Mosheh by יהוה in physical "letter" as a mentor/teacher to keep us 'under' protective custody with the 'hope' of a coming Messiah who would fulfil the promises made in The Torah. Those promises are a Passover sacrifice to make the Torah whole and deliver us from our sin.

יהוה would fulfil His promises to cover our sin by the blood of the lamb in The Covenant with Yahushua by covering the death decrees that demand out death.

Oolasim/Colossians 2

13 And you, being dead in your trespasses [*Eph_2:1*] and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He has made alive together with Him, having forgiven you all trespasses, 14 **having blotted out that which was written by hand against us – by the dogmas – which stood against us.** And He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the stake. [*Qol/Col_2:20; Eph_2:15*]

It is in that way that Yahushua 'fulfilled' The Torah and made it whole! In the process bringing all who lovingly obey the spiritual intent of The Torah into total compliance resulting in eternal life which is the promise made in The Torah for obedience to it.

So, The Torah in the Mosaic Covenant was referred to by the Apostle Sha'ul as *The Torah/Law of Sin and Death* because it was incomplete, and we were being <u>held captive by the fear of the death decrees.</u>

In The (New) Covenant made with Yahushua the Apostle Sha'ul refers to The Torah as *The Torah/Law of the Spirit of Life* because the death decrees have been cover releasing us from bondage to 'sin therefore you die'. The Torah has been fulfilled by covering the death decrees which, the fear of those death decrees had created enmity between us and יהוה. So now יהוה, by removing the death decrees by sacrificing his son in fulfilment of the Avraham/Yitschaq parallel, has now given us a loving heart for His Torah (writing it on our heart) and gave us His Spirit of Set-apartness that teaches us to keep His commandment and obey His Torah, only out of love instead of fear. So now we have 'The Torah/Law of the Spirit of Set-apartness that leads to eternal life' because the death decrees are covered by the blood of the lamb... i.e. *The Torah/Law of the Spirit of Life*! That is the testimony of Yahushua.

The testimony of $\chi\xi\xi$ Jesus is the Torah/Law has been abolished, i.e. **The Lawless One.** $\chi\xi\xi$ Jesus Christ also fulfils the role of "the Beast/Pig sacrifice of Ishtar" in Mystery Babylon. $\chi\xi\xi$ Jesus Christ was created in the image of all pagan gods which is the Trinity.
