Is wearing a real hair wig kosher?



In many Orthodox Jewish communities, it's common to see women wearing head coverings, including scarves, hats, and <u>wigs</u>. Some will wear this covering all the time, while others only wear it when praying or entering a synagogue.

After an Orthodox woman gets married, she covers her hair when she goes outside. When women wear a headscarf or a wig called a "sheitel" in Yiddish, it shows others that they are married and **follow traditional customs of behaving.**



Rivqah/Rebekah saw Yitschaq/Isaac for the first time, and it inspired a custom in Scripture. She got off the camel and asked the servant, "Who is that man coming towards us. "The servant said, "That is my master [and by implication your bridegroom]." Then she covered herself with a veil [as a bride is wearing to signify that she has kept herself pure for her bridegroom]. (Bereshit/Genesis 24:64) This tradition of covering the hair started in the 15th century and has been followed in Orthodox Judaism ever since.

In the very religious Hassidic communities in Eastern Europe during the 1700s, many women would cut off all their hair after getting married and wear a headscarf called a "tichel" or a wig.

Let's examine some Scriptures:

Qorintiyim Aleph 11/1 Corinthians

the head of a wife is her husband, and the head of Messiah is יהוה.

Every man who prays or prophesies with his head covered dishonors his head [Messiah], but every wife who prays or prophesies [in public] with her head uncovered [without her husband] dishonors her head [her husband], since it is the same as if her head were shaven. ...

Oorintiyim Aleph /1 Corinthians 11 ESV

15 But if a woman has long hair, it is her glory? For *her hair* is given to her for a covering.

Vayiqra/Leviticus 21 ESV

5 They shall not make bald patches on their heads *Yehezkel/Ezekiel 44 ESV*

20 They shall not shave their heads

Qorintiyim Aleph /1 Corinthians 11 ESV

14 Does not nature itself teach you that if a man wears long hair it is a disgrace for him, but if a woman has long hair, it is her glory? 15 For her hair is given to her for a covering.

However, the various types of orthodoxy slowly changed how they **understood the tradition**, going from covering the hair completely after the wedding to only covering some of it. Today, religious Jewish women cover their hair with a **wig**, scarf, bonnet, beret, or hairnet.

The Rabbis who don't like real hair wigs are not being picky for no reason. The main issue is that the hair from India may come from religious ceremonies that worship idols. People who worship a certain god grow their hair as a way

to show respect. They promise to cut their hair at the god's temple as a thank-you when their prayers are answered.

Every year, 20 million people go to the Tirupati temple in Andhra Pradesh. Many of them donate their hair. Six hundred barbers work at the temple to shave the pilgrims' hair around the clock. In the "tonsuring" room at the temple, people sit on the floor with their legs crossed. They bend their heads down so the barber can shave their scalp with a razor blade. The helpers pick up the hair and put it in big containers.

The temple sells the hair to wigmakers and makes 5. 6 million dollars. India's hair business is smaller than China's, but the hair from Indian temples is the most expensive in the industry. Indian hair is usually thinner than Chinese hair and it is more like the hair of people from Europe and America. After being made into long hair, Tirupati hair sells for up to \$165 for every 2. 2 pounds. Short hair costs \$100 for every kilogram. Some strands of hair are bought at a sale and then turned into hair extensions. These extensions are sold to Western women for up to \$3,000 for a whole head of hair.

The issue is that the Torah says we can't worship idols or get any kind of benefit from things that are used in idol worship. This sacrifice is only not allowed when it's like the sacrifices done at the Jewish Temple with meat, flour, oil, wine, and water. However, when the object of idolatrous sacrifice (tikrovet avoda zara) used for worship is broken or damaged in honour of the god, it is forbidden to use it in any way. Moreover, the object that was given up as a sacrifice can never be cancelled out, even if it has been changed or mixed with something else.

This means that when an Indian woman gets her haircut and the barber cuts her hair, they are both giving a gift to their god. **They are not allowed to use the hair for anything, even if it's mixed with other hair later on.** Actually, the ingredient L-Cysteine, made from human hair, would make a food not allowed to eat if the hair is from India. This is because anything offered to idols can never be made okay. This means that any wig made from Indian hair would be not allowed to be worn unless it's certain that none of the hair came from India.

A leading Torah authority, Rabbi Moshe Sternbuch, asserts that there are other problems than just wearing such a wig. Rambam writes that the prohibition against deriving benefit from offerings to idol worship is from the verse, "Nor shall you bring an abhorrence into your house" (Deut. 7:26). Accordingly, he writes, *it should be forbidden to keep such a wig in the home even without wearing it.* Also, since the actual money received for objects sacrificed in idol worship becomes forbidden, one

must be careful not to receive money from one who sells or otherwise works with such wigs. He suggests that one who buys a synthetic wig or other permitted item from a person who profits from such wigs should pay the exact price in cash, or with a check or credit card, in order to avoid receiving change from money that may have been paid for them.

Maran HaGaon Rabbi Elyashiv has also recently prohibited Indian wigs. After sending Rabbi A. D. Dunner from England to India to witness the Tirupati temple ceremony first hand, he ruled as follows: Regarding human hair wigs in Israel, since most are from Indian hair, all are forbidden unless the origin is known. Regarding wigs in other countries, if the majority of wigs are from a permitted source, all wigs are technically permitted, but one must clarify the source of each specific wig. Regarding wigs made from synthetic hair, if they contain human hair as well (which is often the case), they must be treated as other human hair wigs as above. In a case of doubt whether they contain human hair, they are permitted. Rabbi Elyashiv concludes that since objects associated with idol worship are to be burnt in fire, wigs from hair generally known to originate in India (but not specifically from the temple) should be burned, while wigs specifically known to be from the Tirupati temple must be burned.

Avodah Zara [idolatrous sacrifice] and wigs are the BIGGEST SCAM OF THIS GENERATION!

Destroy it! That's the only thing you can do with it. Why? Because each wig labelled as kosher that's being sold has been checked. There are no wigs that are considered kosher. It's not real. Phenomenally the Torah forbids benefiting from idolatry in any way, can't wear it, can't make it, can't sell it, can't have any part of it. This is for all Torah Observant believers regardless of culture or Community.

If the wigs are coming from temples that worship idols [99.99% are from temples], then permission was given in the past. This happened before these temples became a big part of the world's wig market.

Bottom line is, if you're wearing a real hair wig, you have a severe problem with יהוה until you destroy it. The kosher certification on wigs is the biggest scam of the generation.

Hair serves a spiritual purpose. Hair is both the vessel for and conduit of spiritual energy, allowing you to open yourself up to divine influences. Why do you believe you are being encouraged to harm your antennas?

That is why shaving your head is forbidden:

<u>Yehezkel/Ezekiel 44 ESV</u> 20 They shall not shave their heads

Hair is like a conduit for divine energy and inspiration, acting as high-tension wires transmitting these qualities from the Source, יהוה. - 4 but the hidden man of the heart, with the incorruptible ornament of a meek and peaceable spirit, which is of great value before Elohim.
- 5 For in this way, in former times, the set-apart women who trusted in Elohim also adorned themselves, being subject to their own husbands
