2025 - 2026 Tuition

Payment accepted: Cash, Check (made payable to Roberts Dance), Visa, Mastercard and Discover

Ways to Pay: Through your account on Dance Studio Pro, Over the phone during office hours, Locked mailbox located on the outside of the studio, in our office during office hours.

Payment due date: Your payment is due by the 5th of each month. All accounts not paid by the 5th will have their card on file ran with a \$5.00 administration fee added. All fami-lies are required to have a current and up to date credit card on file in our office.

Monthly Tuition:

30 minute class \$50.00 per month

15 minute Solo class \$60.00 per month

30 minute Solo class \$120.00 per month

15 minute duet / trio \$35.00 per person per month

Multi Class / Sibling Discounts:

First class full price

Second class \$10.00 off

Third class \$15.00 off

Fourth class \$20.00 off

Discount ends when classes are at \$30.00

**Solos, Duets & Trios are not eligible for discounts.

Tuition Caps – Tuition cap is a payment made per month and includes unlimited classes in your dancer's age and level (solo, duet & trio are not included in tuition caps).

\$275.00 - Individual tuition Cap

\$375.00 - Family tuition Cap

- 1. Each family is required to have a credit card on file with us. You have the option to pay your class fees via check, cash or card prior to the 5th of the month. On the 6th, if you have not paid, your credit card on file will be run for your tuition amount plus \$5.00 for running the card.
- 2. If your card is declined, you will have 24 hours to get us payment or new card information or a \$25.00 late fee will be applied to your account.
- 3. If you decide to withdraw your dancer from our program, you need to do so by emailing the studio before the 5th of that month or your card will be charged.
- 4. You must have a \$0.00 balance on your account before you can purchase tickets to the Holiday show or June show.
- 5. We are a tuition based program. Each month will be the same monthly fees. Tuition is spread out through 10 months for your convenience.

STUDIO POLICIES

- 1. Snow days—If we cancel classes due to weather, we will do the following:
- Mass email
- Mass text
- Post on Facebook
- 2. Personal belongings—All dancers need to have all of their belongings in a dance bag that they keep in the studio with them unless their parent is present. Please label all dance shoes with your dancers name or initials. No food or beverage inside the dance studios (aside from water bottles) and absolutely no gum in the dance rooms.
- 3. Cell phones—All cell phones must remain in dance bags and silenced. Dancers will not be permitted to check their phones during their class. If a student is distracted by or consistently checking their smart watch, their teacher may ask them to keep their watch in their dance bag.
- 4. Dress Code—Our studio dress code will be strictly enforced. If a student repeatedly comes to class not in dress code, we will send an email to the parent(s).
- 5. Account balance—must be at \$0 for dancer to be able to participate and parent to purchase tickets to both the holiday and June show.

- 6. Respect for teachers and students—We expect all of our students to show respect to-wards their teachers and fellow dancers.
- Not talking when the teacher is talking—what is said to one applies to all
- Raising your hand to ask a question
- Being on time, dressed appropriately for class and ready to work
- 7. Concerns / Questions—If you have any questions or concerns we ask that you please do not ask your child's teacher in between classes or during classes as this holds them up from starting their next class on time. You can email the studio or talk to our office staff who will get the message to the appropriate person who will then contact you.
- 8. Observation / waiting rooms—We encourage parents throughout the year to make use of our observation windows to observe your child's class. Please keep the waiting area quiet so parents can enjoy watching their child's classes and so it does not disrupt any classes that are in session. No parents, siblings or friends will be allowed in the dance rooms.
- 9. Injury / missing items—The studio is not held responsible if a child is injured or a belonging is lost or stolen. If a child is injured, we will apply basic first aid and take other actions if need be.
- 10. If a student comes into class not feeling well or say they are injured and need to sit out (without a note from their parents), parents will be called from the office to inform them of the illness or injury.

THE NUTCRACKER WITH A TWIST

The Nutcracker with a twist will be the traditional Nutcracker story with a twist! We will be incorporating all styles of dance into this production! All of our dance classes will be involved with this show aside from:

- Acro Classes, Tumbling Tots, Parent & Me, Cheer, Musical Theater, Competitive Teams, Adult classes, solos, duets & trios
- 1. This show will be held in December at Kent Roosevelt High School Auditorium. We will know the specific date in the fall and will let families know ASAP.
- 2. Tickets will need to be purchased for this show—\$17 per ticket.
- 3. Costumes—Each dancer participating in the show will be required to pay a \$30.00 recital fee. This fee covers a t-shirt for each dancer and costume rentals, maintenance and cleaning. We do not purchase costumes for this show. Dancers borrow costumes for the show and then return them after the show is over.

JUNE SHOW

Our big end of the year show will be the 3rd weekend in June held at Kent Roosevelt High School Auditorium. All of our classes participate in the show (aside from acro & tumbling tots). This show is optional and costumes for this show will need to be purchased.

Tickets for the show—\$17 each

Costume fees—Range from \$60-\$90 per class. Costume fees will be billed in October with fees being due in December.

LIABILITY WAIVER

Must be signed and turned into our office before your child can start dancing. As with all physical activity there is a risk of injury. Even though The Roberts Conservatory of Dance takes precautions to assure a safe environment, physical activities such as those taught or participated in at The Roberts Conservatory of Dance have a risk of injury. I agree to be solely responsible for all costs incurred by me and / or my child as a result of any injury sustained from participation in any classes while at The Roberts Conservatory of Dance or at another location with The Roberts Conservatory of Dance. If a parent or guardian is not present, I authorize The Roberts Conservatory of Dance staff, in the event of illness or injury, to administer emergency care and to arrange for any emergency medical transportation to the nearest healthcare facility deemed appropriate. I understand that every effort will be made to contact the parent, guardian or emergency contact prior to any involved treatment. I agree that my insurance carrier or I will bear financial responsibility for any medical treatment administered under the above guidelines. Please initial below:
