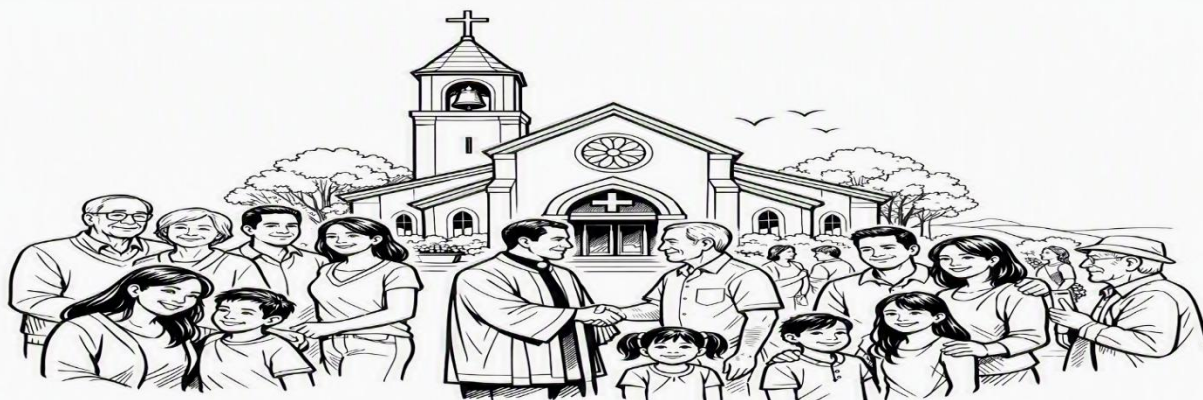

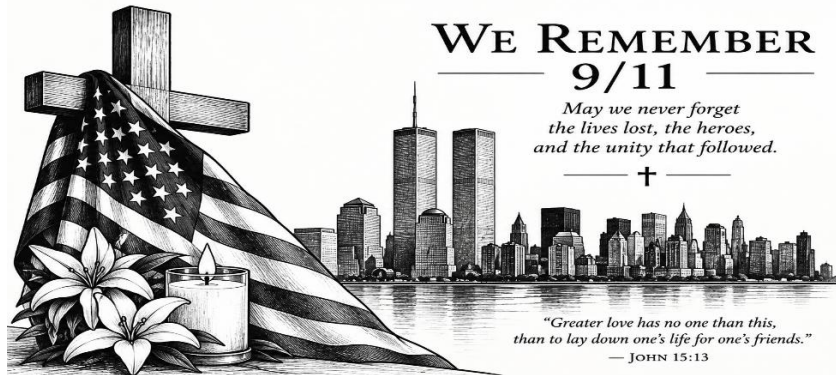

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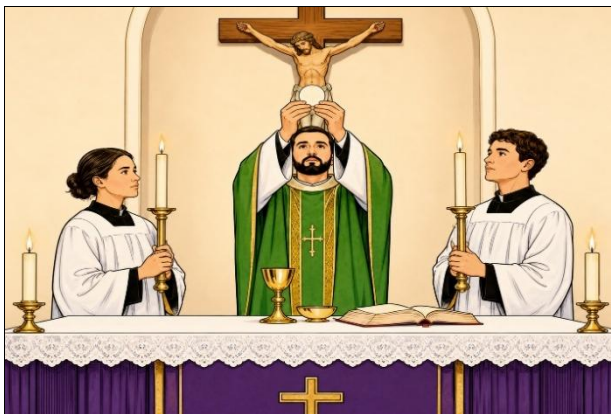

Mike was upset. Being team captain was really important to him. He thought about it and decided to explain what was going on. "Coach, I'm sorry. My grandma has been very sick, and I've been really worried. I was late because I had to take her to an appointment. I know I haven't been focused, but we have her care better organized now. I can do my duties as captain again."

Coach listened with compassion. He said, "Mike, I'm sorry to hear about your grandmother. That must be very stressful for you. You can stay as captain. If you need to be late for family reasons, just let me know and we'll work something out."

Mike felt so relieved. Coach had shown him mercy. He had been kinder than Mike deserved. Mike realized he should have explained sooner.

But the very next week, one of Mike's teammates, Joe, missed a practice. When Mike saw him the next day, he didn't even give him a chance to explain. "Joe, you're not a team player," Mike snapped. "You missed practice. You're benched for a week."

Joe tried to explain. "I'm sorry, Mike. My brother was in an accident and I had to be with him at the hospital. He's okay now, and it won't happen again."

But Mike didn't listen. "Excuses are worthless. You're still benched. I'm telling Coach."

When the other players heard about this, they were upset. They went to Coach first and explained what happened. They thought it was unfair. Joe was a good teammate, but he had missed practice for a serious reason.

So when Mike went to Coach to report Joe, Coach already knew the whole story. He said, "Mike, one of the main jobs of the captain is to encourage the team and build morale. When you told me about your grandmother, I wanted to support you. But when Joe missed one practice because of his brother's accident, instead of showing support, you wanted to punish him. That is not the right attitude for a captain. I'm sorry, but I'm replacing you."

What do we learn from this story about mercy? Was Coach merciful? He was. Was Mike merciful? He was not. What should he have done instead?

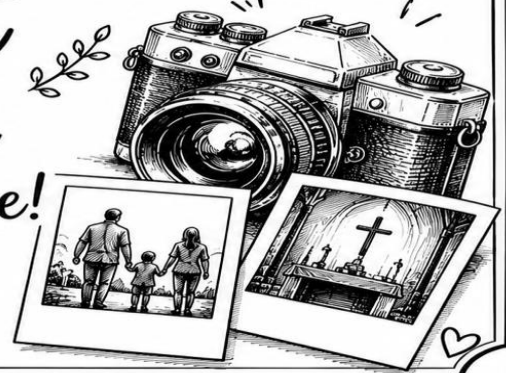

Patronal Feast of the Holy Name of Mary

"God the Father gathered all the waters together and called them the seas or *maria* in Latin. He gathered all His grace together and called them Mary or Maria...whom the Saints call the 'treasury of the Lord'. From Her fullness all men are made rich."

Saint Louis de Montfort, 1673-1716

The universal Church celebrates 12 September as the Feast of the Holy Name of Mary. It was established by Pope Innocent XI in thanksgiving for the Blessed Mother's intercession against the siege of Vienna by the Ottoman Turks on 12 September 1683 at the hand of the great Polish general John Sobieski (1629-1696). It is the patronal feast of the parish of Holy Name of Mary and a cause for great joy and celebration shared between our two linked parishes.

In Hebrew, the name Mary is Miryam. Derived from the root, *merur*, the name signifies "bitterness". Miryam was the sister of Moses; and the ancient rabbinical scholars perceiving in it a symbol of the slavery of the Israelites at the hands of the Egyptians, held that Miryam was given this name because she was born during the time of the oppression of her people. Miryam is a "type" of the Blessed Virgin. Miryam was a prophetess who sang a song of thanksgiving after the Israelites safely crossed the Red Sea and Pharaoh's army in pursuit was destroyed. Mary prophesied in Her Magnificat that all generations would call Her blessed, and She sang of how God would topple the proud and raise the lowly.

Richard of Saint Laurence states "there is not such powerful help in any name, nor is there any other name given to men, after that of Jesus, from which so much salvation is poured forth upon men as from the name of Mary." Hence, he "encourages sinners to have recourse to this great name," because it alone will suffice to cure them of all their evils; and "there is no disorder, however malignant, that does not immediately yield to the power of the name of Mary."

May the sweet and powerful name of Mary be our protection and guide, now and at the hour of our death.

Fiesta Patronal del Santo Nombre de María

“Dios Padre reunió todas las aguas y las llamó mares o maria en latín. Reunió toda su gracia y la llamó María o Maria... a quien los santos llaman el “tesoro del Señor”. De su plenitud todos los hombres son enriquecidos.”

San Luis María Grignon de Montfort, 1673-1716

La Iglesia universal celebra el 12 de septiembre como la Fiesta del Santo Nombre de María. Fue instituida por el Papa Inocencio XI en acción de gracias por la intercesión de la Santísima Virgen contra el asedio de Viena por los turcos otomanos el 12 de septiembre de 1683, a manos del gran general polaco Juan Sobieski (1629-1696). Es la fiesta patronal de la parroquia del Santo Nombre de María y motivo de gran alegría y celebración compartida entre nuestras dos parroquias vinculadas.

En hebreo, el nombre de María es Miryam. Derivado de la raíz *merur*, el nombre significa “amargura”. Miryam era hermana de Moisés; y los antiguos eruditos rabínicos, al percibir en él un símbolo de la esclavitud de los israelitas a manos de los egipcios, sostenían que Miryam recibió este nombre porque nació durante la época de opresión de su pueblo. Miryam es un “tipo” de la Santísima Virgen. Miryam fue una profetisa que cantó un cántico de acción de gracias después de que los israelitas cruzaran sanos y salvos el Mar Rojo y el ejército del faraón que los perseguía fuera destruido. María profetizó en su Magnificat que todas las generaciones la llamarían bienaventurada, y cantó cómo Dios derribaría a los soberbios y exaltaría a los humildes. Ricardo de San Lorenzo afirma: “No hay ayuda tan poderosa en ningún nombre, ni hay otro nombre dado a los hombres, después del de Jesús, del que se derrame tanta salvación sobre ellos como del nombre de María”. Por lo tanto, “anima a los pecadores a recurrir a este gran nombre, porque solo él bastará para curarlos de todos sus males; y no hay trastorno, por maligno que sea, que no ceda inmediatamente al poder del nombre de María”.

Que el dulce y poderoso nombre de María sea nuestra protección y guía, ahora y en la hora de nuestra muerte.
