### 1st Reading: Job 38:1, 8-11

God created all, including the seas and storms that form upon the seas. Job, like every created thing, can never understand God's purpose, especially those things that seem unfair or unjust. Job was a just man, a good man who always obeyed the Law and loved God with all his heart, but he couldn't accept the injustice of senseless suffering: what did I do Lord to deserve this? But the plain and simple fact is that God's ways are not our ways and the very best that we can do is to recognize God's sovereignty and then bow down before it. In love of God we can find acceptance, if not complete understanding.

# **2nd Reading: 2 Corinthians 5:14-17**

Paul's epistles generally address issues within a given community, and sometimes those issues are hard to understand today. Scholars believe that the issue here is one of wandering preachers teaching false doctrine, namely, that Jesus Christ is a human miracle worker. Paul explains that Jesus is much more than that; Jesus is the resurrected One who died for us and now lives for us so that we too are 'new creatures' living in Him.

## Gospel Reading: Mark 4:35-41

The disciples do not know who Jesus really is, nor *will they know*, until the crucifixion/resurrection. Mark is pointing this out (in this passage). When Jesus calms the storm, he is operating as a great prophet with the power of God. In the Hebrew Scriptures control over the uncontrollable natural world connotes the divine, and this story is intended to frame Jesus as a divine presence for all who hear (or read) the story.
