Chairs opening remarks

1/12/24. **Apologies for absence** None

2/12/24. **Public session** . 3 members of the public attended. Potholes at the turning left going to Tremaine and another before the bridge. Clerk to contact highways and suggested by Cllr Bettesworth that the contact link be added to the website,

Also mentioned by a member of the public that the storm has damaged the Perspex window from the village hall noticeboard and it will require replacement. Proposed by Cllr Bellis that the PC sort and fund this from CIL money seconded by Cllr Bellis.

CC were asking if PC wished to take this over. It was unanimously felt this would incur a lot of extra cost with maintenance etc with little or no benefit for the Parish. Therefore declined. 8//24. **Planning** – PA24/04176 approved. PA24/08570 and PA24/08572 no concerns raised by council and no correspondence from local parishoners regarding this.

9//24. **Parish Matters** – play equipment catalogues received, correspondence from one parishioner requesting the area be mindful of all age groups. Adam has discussed with the children who attend gymanastics and they request swings, slide and zip wire! We need to accommodate this as much as we can. He also identified that the hedges in the amenity field need care and suggested contacting Langore Tree surgeon to see if we can have a community event with the community being

taught how to do the hedging with his knowledge and supervision. Unanimously agreed, may be a cost to the PC which agreed we will also provide tea and biscuits. Cllr Bettesworth to contact the company.
