So that we are able to better serve you in a professional, efficient, and courteous manner, we ask that ALL students/guardians abide by our policies:

Tuition

- Tuition is to be paid (in full) by the first lesson each month (following the Donley's Calendar)
- Tuition can be paid at the front counter via cash, check, credit or debit card, or automatic bill pay through your bank
- The second lesson of the month will not be given until tuition for the month is paid in full
- If payment is not paid on time a \$30 late fee will be added to the month's tuition
- NO PRORATING. We ONLY prorate if you enroll in lessons in the middle of the month

Missed Lessons and Make-up Lessons

If a student misses a regularly scheduled lesson, they will be eligible for a make-up lesson as long as the following guidelines are observed:

- At least 24 hours notice is provided to the instructor for all missed lessons (aside from emergencies)
- It is the responsibility of the student/guardian to schedule the make-up lesson within 30 days of the missed lesson
- The date, time, and method of the make-up lesson is entirely up to the instructor and their schedule
- Instructors reserve the right to refuse make-up lessons to students that demonstrated habitual absences, are not up to date on tuition, or if appropriate notice is not given

Lesson Discontinuances

- If a student wishes to stop lessons, they MUST provide the instructor with a two week notice, as a courtesy to the instructor
- All tuition must be paid through the two week notice period, regardless if the student chooses to attend
 the lessons or not
