✓ Your PCP will discuss if in-home support would help with personal care, mobility, safety, or other daily needs.



VA Request Submitted

✓ If approved, your PCP will submit a request for HHA services through the HSRM VA system.



Social Worker Call for ADL Needs

✓ A VA Social Worker will call you to discuss your Activities of Daily Living (ADL) needs and determine weekly hours for support.





What's Needed and Why

Understanding Eligibility Requirements for Veterans

What's Needed



A Documented Medical Need

Documentation of a health condition that makes daily care at home necessary.



Difficulty With Activities of Daily Living (ADLs)

An inability to perform ADLs like bathing, dressing, grooming, mobility assistance, meal prep, and medication reminders.



Safety Concerns in the Home

Risk factors like falls or getting safely to the bathroom that make staying at home without help risky.



VA Evaluation & Approval

A professional assessment and formal VA approval are required.

Why It's Needed



For Proper Accountability & Safety

A medical need establishes that in-home care is justified, preventing misuse of VA resources.



To Ensure that Care is Truly Needed

Verification that help with ADLs is needed ensures that services are correctly matched to the Veteran's needs.



To Protect Veterans from Harm

Safety concerns highlight the real-world dangers Veterans face when left alone, justifying the need for care.



For Compliance with Program Rules

Evaluation and approval by the VA ensure services align with regulations and are provided legally and appropriately.
