Goal: As a BSYC Sailing Instructor, you will actively support our Sailing Program to Providing a Safe, Effective and Fun environment for students to learn how to become better sailors and enjoy our club and the Great South Bay.

BSYC – JYC – Sailing Instructor Position Description 2023

Expectations

- Safety of people above all
- Safety of equipment
- Lead by example:
 - At all times, behave in a way that protects personal and student safety
 - Be supportive and assist your students as they learn new skills: recognize progress and offer praise every
 - Show respect for people, procedures, rules, boats, and equipment
 - Demonstrate professional conduct: focus is on everybody learning how to be better sailors

Selection Criteria:

- Minimum age of 16 by first Class of JYC Program
- Successfully pass all US SAILING Level 1 Small Boat Certificate requirements.
- Minimum of three years sailing experience as skipper
- Preferred, but not required experience as motorboat skipper
- Preferred, but not required, at least two years' experience racing as either crew or skipper
- Preferred, but not required, previous experience instructing sports skills

Required Duties (Include, but are not limited to):

- Follow Curriculum provided by Head Instructor
- Follow US Sailing teaching format:
 - Chalk Talks
 - Land Drills
 - Instructor Demonstrations
 - On the Water Drills
 - Participate in periodic End of the Day and End of Week Debriefing Sessions

Each Instructor will be personally responsible for a group of Students and will oversee the documentation of their progress throughout the entire Sailing Program (see US SAILING Small Boat Sailor Certification Record Book, a.k.a. "The Little Red Book")

Guide students in setting up their boats and stowing them away at end of day,

- Includes securing all equipment and dock lines,
- Freshwater rinse for all boats (including Safety Boats),
- Coiling hoses, etc.

Guide students in using and maintaining the JYC facility, Sail Shack, other storage lockers, and dock areas in neat and tidy condition.

- Participate in Regattas both away and at hosted by BSYC
- Set up course markers
- Loading them into Safety Boat
- Setting and retrieving them while out on the water
- Stowing them away at end of day in Sail Shack
- Participate in BSYC events when appropriate
