

STUDIO POLICY 2022

Tuition and Calendar Year

Classes begin the week of September 19, 2022 and end June 20, 2022. There are no classes on all statutory holidays, Christmas Break, or March Break. Each term is 12 weeks consisting of 11 weeks of regular classes and 1 week of piano parties or virtual recital. See dates below or refer to see studio calendar.

Term 1

Classes September 19 - December 2 (no classes October 10)

Piano Parties December 5 & 6

Term 2

Classes January 2 - March 24 (no classes February 20 and March 13 - 17)

Piano Parties March 27 & 28

Term 3

Classes April 3 - June 16 (no classes April 7-10, or May 22)

Virtual Recital June 20

Tuition includes lesson time, access to recorded videos and transcript, detailed homework assignments, video demonstrations, and interactive homework games. It does not include books. You will be provided with a book list upon registering and will be required to purchase books commonly available at your local music store or on Amazon. Every year, tuition fees will increase slightly. You will be notified of the new rates in the summer before each new school year.

45 Minute Weekly Group Lessons (Intro and Beginner)	\$480
60 Minute Weekly Group Lessons (Early Elementary and up)	\$660
60 Minute Weekly Private Lessons	\$960

Optional Add-Ons (subject to availability. Only available for students enrolled in a class above)

20 Minute Private - Full term	\$330
20 Minute Private	\$30
45 Minute Private	\$60
60 Minute Private	\$80



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Required Materials

To get the most out of online piano lessons, students are required to have the following:

- High speed internet
- A computer or laptop (No phones or tablets)
- A quiet place for lessons
- Acoustic or weighted piano
- Books
- A basket of essentials (dice for games, coloured pencils/crayons, pen or pencil, fidget toys if needed)
- Either a printer and binder for assignments or a tablet to view assignments

Expectations of Students

Students are expected to try their best and be respectful to all. During lessons, students are welcome to use fidget toys, stim, turn off their camera, communicate through the chat box, and find ways to help themselves engage or take a break as necessary. Intro and beginner students are expected to practice 10-15 minutes a day and complete all homework to the best of their ability.

Expectations of Parents

Parents are expected to support their child by printing out homework assignments, getting the required books, and being available to troubleshoot technical problems. Parents are also responsible for helping the child set up a practice schedule and reminding them to practice.
