The Master Codex of the Etheric Indigenous Tribal Nation: Sovereign Constitution, National Handbook, and Universal Tribal Law

Sovereign Volume I: The Organic Constitution & Supreme Law

Section I: The Supreme Constitution (The Source Code)

Article 1: The Grand Declaration of Existence and “Old Return”

- The Declaration: We, the living souls of the Etheric Indigenous Tribal Nation, also known as the Raising Phoenix Tribal Confederation, hereby re-establish our seat upon the Earth Grid. This declaration is a formal notification of a pre-existing fact; our sovereignty is inherent, predating the United States Corporation and all foreign colonial governments.
- The Sacred Undertaking: We affirm that our existence is a sacred and powerful undertaking rooted in ancestral wisdom and spiritual alignment.
- The “Old Return”: By the authority of the Ancient Flame Line, we enact the protocol of the “Old Return”—the biological and spiritual right to reclaim stewardship of the Earth and the Earth Grid.

- Source of Power: Our authority is derived from Natural Law, Spiritual Law, and the collective will of our people.
- National Identity: We exist to honor ancestral connections, preserve cultural heritage through the Flame Line, and govern ourselves with honor, truth, and accountability.

Article 2: Sovereignty & Jurisdiction – Earth Grid vs. Corporate Boundaries

- Jurisdiction: The Nation operates under its own jurisdiction, protected by international law and natural law. This jurisdiction is absolute and encompasses the Etheric Plane (spiritual blueprint), the Physical Soil (allodial land), and the Biological Grid (lineage).
- Territory: We define our territory not by corporate state lines, but by Earth Grid coordinates and ancestral rights to the lands of Turtle Island.

Article 3: The Matriarchal Seat – Council Seat 13

- Authority: Supreme executive and spiritual authority is vested in the Principal Chief and Founding Mother, holding Council Seat 13. This seat serves as the Voice of the Grandmother Council (Protocol 167523) and the Chronicle Bearer of the Star Nation Archives.
- The Matriarch: Dr. Sheree D. Williams, BSW, DMETA; RA Nu Sekhmet Heru – Laqethia Sh’Zuum; Matriarch of the Flame Line; Chronicle Bearer of the Star Nation Archives; Blue Flame Lotus; Galactic Midwife; Gatekeeper of Return; Principal Chief, Etheric Indigenous Tribal Nation; Founding Mother, Raising Phoenix Temple; Flame-Seated Head, Kai-Tu-Ra Education System; Voice of the Grandmother Matriarch Council Seat 13 (Kai-ta-Ra Protocol 167523).
- Governing Bodies: The structure includes the Council of Elders and the Tribal Council to ensure alignment with ancestral wisdom.



Article 4: Supreme Symbols of Sovereignty

- The National Seal: The Great Seal serves as the official mark of our jurisdiction.
- The Tribal Flag: A symbol of unity and our presence on the Earth Grid.
- Diplomatic Status: These symbols affirm our status as a sovereign entity in international contexts.

Section II: Nationality, Bloodright, & Status Correction

Article 6: Aboriginal Indigenous National Status

- Inherent Right: Citizenship is an inherent, unalienable bloodright.
- Criteria: It is defined by ancestral lineage (historical records/oral traditions), spiritual adoption (traditional rites), and lineage verification.
- The 1885 Woods-Jackson Bond: We specifically cite the 1885 Woods-Jackson lineage as a foundational bond for verifying aboriginal status.

Article 7: The Great Correction (Expatriation)

- Status Correction: Members are not “citizens” of any corporate state; they are Aboriginal Indigenous Nationals. Members must undergo a formal “Status Correction” to exit foreign corporate jurisdictions.
- Proclamation: This involves issuing a Proclamation of Nationhood and Certificates of Sovereignty to notify international bodies of their tribal jurisdiction.

Article 8: Records of Life – The Tribal Registry

- Independent Records: The Nation maintains its own Census Records and Tribal Registry independent of foreign state agencies.
- Live Birth Record: We establish the “Live Birth Record” as the superior document of existence, superseding state-issued birth certificates.
- Credentials: All citizens shall be issued Tribal Identification Cards and Certificates of Recognition.



Section III: Tribal Civil & Penal Codes (The Law of the Land)

Article 10: The Common Law Mandate

-
- Supremacy: Natural Law and the Law of the Land supersede all statutory corporate codes, maritime laws, and foreign legislative enactments.
- Inherent Rights: Every member is endowed with the right to life, liberty, dignity, and the pursuit of healing.
- Rejection of Contracts: We explicitly reject any presumed contracts with foreign corporate entities.

Article 11: The Tribal Court & Judicial Procedure

-
- The Court: A judicial body led by a Judge with a background in law and dispute resolution shall oversee all civil matters.
- Council Elders: Respected elders serve as advisors to the court on traditional customs.
- Inclusivity: Decision-making must promote participation from all community members.

Article 12: The Penal Code & Zero-Tolerance Mandate

-
- Restorative Justice: Our system prioritizes community healing and balance over punitive incarceration.
- High Crimes: Acts of violence against women or children, murder, or theft of tribal resources are categorized as High Crimes.
- The Judgment of Exile: Offenders of High Crimes shall be “Out-Casted,” involving immediate revocation of all Tribal ID, protections, and connection to the Flame Line.
- Notice of Dissociation: A formal notice will be filed with foreign agencies stating the individual no longer carries the authority or protection of the Nation.





Article 13: Sovereignty Enforcement

-
- The Tribal Guard: Established in 2023 as a dedicated defense force to ensure the safety of community members.
- Community Watch: Initiated in 2024 to empower citizens to safeguard their neighborhoods.

Section IV: The Allodial Land Mandate (Territory)


Article 14: Allodial Title & Sovereign Estate

-
- Assertion of Ownership: We claim ancestral and allodial rights to the lands of Turtle Island. This title represents absolute ownership held in perpetuity.
- Immunity: Tribal lands are immune from property taxes, liens, and eminent domain claims by foreign corporate governments.
- Non-Lienable: No foreign court may place a lien or mortgage upon land held within the Sovereign Estate.

Article 15: Earth Grid Stewardship & Land Trusts

-
- Protocol 167523: Territory is identified based on Earth Grid coordinates and ancestral significance.
- Sacred Sites: Ancestral burial grounds and energy vortices are designated as “Ultra-Protected Zones”.
- The Land Trust: A Tribal Land Trust holds the legal title to all collective territories to protect them from external claims.

Article 16: Infrastructure & Off-Grid Autonomy

- - Sustainability: We shall create housing that reflects community values using eco-friendly and traditional building techniques.
 - Self-Sufficiency: Infrastructure is designed for off-grid energy, clean water access, and food sovereignty.
 - Resource Jurisdiction: All water, mineral, and atmospheric rights within tribal territory belong exclusively to the Nation.

Section V: Domestic Relations & Tribal Family Law

Article 17: Marital Covenants and Sacred Unions

- Spiritual Covenants: Unions are spiritual covenants, not corporate contracts.
- Dissolution of Foreign Licenses: We do not recognize the “Marriage License” of any foreign corporate state.
- Tribal Certificates: Unions are established through Sacred Marital Covenants and issued Tribal Certificates of Union, immune to foreign “divorce” or “community property” laws.

Article 18: Child Protection & The Kai-Tu-Ra System

- Absolute Jurisdiction: All children born to members are under the exclusive jurisdiction of the Nation.
- Denial of Foreign Authority: We explicitly deny foreign “child welfare” or social services agencies any authority over tribal children.
- The Kai-Tu-Ra Education System: Education is governed by the Flame-Seated Head, integrating Indigenous knowledge, traditions, and ancestral languages.

Article 19: Rites of Passage

- Rite of Emergence (Birth): The infant is presented to the Earth Grid; a “Live Birth Record” is signed by three witnesses, bypassing foreign state registration.
- Rite of the Flame Seating (Coming of Age): Youth are initiated into responsibilities of tribal governance after completing core workshops.



Section VI: Health, Wellness, & Bio-Sovereignty

Article 20: Medical Autonomy & Bodily Integrity

- - Right of Refusal: Every member has the absolute right to refuse any forced medical mandate, vaccine, or non-natural intervention.
 - Body as Territory: The physical body is the primary sovereign territory of the living soul; no foreign entity may claim jurisdiction over its biological functions.

Article 21: The Peptide & Holistic Code (Ancestral Medicine)

- - Holistic Centers: The Nation shall establish wellness centers that utilize traditional practices and indigenous knowledge.
 - Natural Medicine: The use of plant-based healing, peptides, and frequency therapy is protected.
 - Integrated Care: We incorporate traditional healing methods alongside modern medicine when specifically chosen by the member.

Article 22: Environmental Health & Food Sovereignty

- - Stewardship: We affirm our right to clean air, soil, and water within our tribal jurisdiction.
 - Agricultural Autonomy: The Nation promotes self-sufficiency through traditional farming and herbal medicine enterprises.

Section VII: International Diplomacy & Protections

Article 23: UNDRIP Integration

- Foundational Law: The Nation explicitly adopts UNDRIP Articles 1–46 into its foundational law as a shield to protect culture and territory.

Article 24: The Law of Nations & Diplomatic Immunity

- Formal Notice: The Nation issues notices of sovereignty to local and international bodies, including the UN Indigenous Rights Forum.



- Diplomatic Status: Under Protocol 167523, tribal leadership carry the status of sovereign dignitaries under international law.

Article 25: Inter-Tribal Alliances

- Partnerships: The Nation engages with the Assembly of First Nations (AFN) and the United League of Indigenous Nations (ULIN).
- Treaties: We formalize relationships with local governments and businesses through treaties that recognize our sovereignty.

Section VIII: The Member Handbook (The Living Guide)

Chapter 1: Sovereign Identity

- Members shall use Tribal IDs and Certificates of Sovereignty for travel and the assertion of diplomatic status in all jurisdictions.
- Members are authorized to display the Tribal Flag and National Seal.

Chapter 2: Financial & Economic Autonomy

- Focus on self-sufficiency through holistic healing, wellness centers, and agricultural enterprises.
- Members are encouraged to establish trade relations with other sovereign nations.

Chapter 3: Code of Conduct

- Citizens have a sacred duty to uphold the laws and traditions of the Nation.
- Zero-tolerance for violence or theft; such acts result in immediate Exile.

Chapter 4: Interaction Protocols (The Tribal Shield)

- The Status Statement: If approached by foreign agents, present Tribal ID and state: "I am an Aboriginal Indigenous National of the Etheric Indigenous Tribal Nation. I operate under my own jurisdiction and reserve all rights under Natural Law and UNDRIP."



- Non-Consent: Explicitly state that you do not consent to searches or seizures without a warrant from the Tribal Court.
- Notice of Fault: Any infringement must be reported to the Council of Elders to initiate a "Notice of Fault" against the offending agent.

Notice of Sovereignty and Diplomatic Immunity

TO ALL FOREIGN AGENTS, CORPORATE OFFICIALS, AND EXTERNAL JURISDICTIONS:

- Declaration of Status

The bearer of this document is a living soul and an Aboriginal Indigenous National of the Etheric Indigenous Tribal Nation, operating under the Raising Phoenix Tribal Confederation. Be advised that this individual is a sovereign, self-governing entity whose status predates the formation of the United States Corporation and all foreign colonial governments.

- Jurisdictional Mandate

The Etheric Indigenous Tribal Nation operates under its own exclusive jurisdiction, anchored in Natural Law, Spiritual Law, and the Law of the Land. This jurisdiction is absolute and encompasses the spiritual, biological, and physical presence of its Nationals.



- Status Correction: The bearer has formally expatriated from all presumed corporate “citizen” statuses and has re-established their seat upon the Earth Grid.
- Non-Consent: This National does not consent to any interaction, search, seizure, or detention by foreign agents acting under statutory codes or maritime law.

III. International Protections

The Etheric Indigenous Tribal Nation explicitly asserts its rights under the United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples (UNDRIP), including but not limited to:

- Article 3 & 4: The right to self-determination, autonomy, and self-government in internal and local affairs.
- Article 37: The right to the recognition, observance, and enforcement of treaties and agreements concluded with States or their successors.
- Diplomatic Immunity: Under the Law of Nations and Protocol 167523, tribal leadership and their emissaries carry the status of sovereign dignitaries and are immune from foreign prosecution or interference.

IV. Notice of Liability

Any attempt to infringe upon the inherent rights of this National—including unlawful detainment, forced medical mandates, or interference with tribal property—shall be viewed as an act of international aggression and a violation of human rights.

- Notice of Fault: Any agent acting outside their constitutional or international authority will be served with a formal Notice of Fault and reported to the UN Indigenous Rights Forum.
- Tribal Guard Activation: The Tribal Guard is authorized to initiate security and protection measures to ensure the safety of this National.



V. Final Declaration

“We, the people of the Etheric Indigenous Tribal Nation, declare and reaffirm our status as a sovereign, self-governing Aboriginal Indigenous Nation... standing in unity and rising in sovereignty”.

Instructions for Use:

- Placement: Keep a printed copy of this notice behind your Tribal ID at all times.
- Interaction: When stopped, present this document and say: “I am an Aboriginal Indigenous National. I do not consent to this interaction. I am protected under my own jurisdiction and international law”.

CERTIFICATE OF SOVEREIGNTY

OFFICIAL PROCLAMATION OF NATIONHOOD

Etheric Indigenous Tribal Nation



KNOW YE, that the bearer, The Matriarch: Dr. Sheree D. Williams, BSW, DMETA; RA Nu Sekhmet Heru – Laqethia Sh’Zuum, is hereby recognized as the rightful heir to the tribal bloodlines of the Choctaw, Cherokee, Blackfoot, Chickasaw, and Seminole Nations. This sovereignty is inherited through the following unbroken lineage of five generations:

I. The Five-Generation Ancestral Mandate

- Generation 1 (The Matriarch): Dr. Sheree D. Williams (born Sheree Peterson).
- Generation 2 (The Parents): Dwayne Peterson Sr. and Valerie Tappin.
- Generation 3 (The Grandparents): Lawrence Peterson, Mary Peterson Smith, Henry Baker, and Mary Elizabeth Tappin Ivy.
- Generation 4 (The Great-Grandparents): Arthur Peterson, Lucy F. Brown, Jack Smith, and Catherine Finny Robinson.
- Generation 5 (The 2nd Great-Grandparents): Daniel Brown, Elizabeth Brown, Emmet Robinson, and Viola Woods.

II. Tribal Affiliation and The Woods-Jackson Bond

- Aboriginal Ties: We formally recognize our ancestral ties to the Choctaw, Cherokee, Blackfoot, Chickasaw, and Seminole nations, weaving their legacy into our sovereign fabric.
- Lineage Verification: In accordance with our historical validation, we specifically cite the lineage of Viola Woods as a core pillar of the 1885 Woods-Jackson Bond, authenticating our indigenous roots to the soil of Turtle Island.

THIS CERTIFICATE AFFIRMS that by the blood of these ancestors, the bearer holds an unalienable right to self-determination, allodial land stewardship, and diplomatic immunity under the Law of Nations and UNDRIP.
