

TOURNAMENT RULES

Code Of Conduct FOR PARENTS



1 POSITIVE ATTITUDE

Support my child with positive encouragement
Respect and adhere to the ideals, policies, and rules determined by Fresh Ice Hockey and my child's team.

2 MAINTAIN SELF CONTROL AT ALL TIMES

Refrain from using foul language towards other parents, coaches, officials or opponents, or any employee of the Tournament Committee. Not physically or verbally abuse any other person.

3 BE NICE TO THE REFEREES

Refrain from yelling at or threatening referees, opposing players or coaches before, during, or after games or practices. Show respect for the decisions, judgment and authority of the officials and timekeepers.

4 DURING THE TOURNAMENT

Avoid confusing your child by coaching from the stands. Refrain from approaching the bench during a game situation unless summoned by a coach. Parents are not allowed in the locker rooms unless for emergency reasons. Parents are not allowed to stay outside the locker rooms in the hallway. Please wait for your child in the common area.

5 SPORTSMANSHIP

Exhibit a high degree of sportsmanship, teamwork and positive attitude at all times when representing my child and the NHLKIDS. Refrain from demonstrating frustration or anger after a loss or poor performance. Accept defeat gracefully...love the game above the prize.

6 ATTENDANCE

Encourage my child to attend as many games and practices as reasonably possible in a timely manner. Notify the coach/manager and administration ahead of time of absences.

7 THE 24 HOUR RULE

Gain an understanding of the NHLKIDS 24 hour rule to deal with team complaints and adhere to it. Complaints are accepted via email only. Send your complaint with details to committee@freshicehockey.ca and the disciplinary team will contact you in a brief delay.

8 PLEASE DO NOT

- Try and locate the tournament coordinator in the arena to address your questions or concerns. Contact administration who will redirect you.
- Send your complaints to our team via direct message on social media.
- Send your complaints to administration via email.
- Send your complaints to the Tournament coordinator or administration via text messages.

9 FOLLOW THE RULES

There will be penalties for those who do not abide by the 24 hour rule. We have a strict zero tolerance policy for any verbal abuse towards the referees or any other members of the Tournament Committee. This could result in immediate game suspension. Thank you for your understanding!

1 POSITIVE ATTITUDE

2 SPORTSMANSHIP

Exhibit a high degree of sportsmanship, teamwork and positive attitude at all times when representing my team and the NHLKIDS. Accept defeat gracefully...love the game above the prize

3 RESPECT

Show respect for the decisions, judgment and authority of the officials and timekeepers. Refrain from using foul language towards teammates, coaches, officials or opponents. Respect the facilities in which we play.

4 FACILITIES

PLEASE DO NOT

- Run around the arena, play fight, chase each other, spray water etc.
- Yell, scream, use foul or inappropriate language.
- Take things that don't belong to you.
- Leave your garbage around, litter etc.

5 ATTENDANCE

Attend as many games and practices as reasonably possible
Be present before games and practices in a timely manner
Notify the coach ahead of time if I will be absent.

6 DRESS CODE

Jerseys, pant shells, socks, helmet, gloves and team bag are mandatory during games and practices (practice jersey for practices) Sunday arrive for the playoffs in formal wear, dress pants, dress shirt, no joggings and no jeans. Collared shirt required. During the tournament please do not wear rivalry team apparel.

7 OFFICIAL GAME JERSEYS

Please do not leave the locker room with your game jersey in your hockey bag. There will be a rack in your locker room with hangers. There will be a jersey cleaning and maintenance service. Under no circumstances are game jerseys to leave the arena.
