

AFFIDAVIT OF VACCINE EXEMPTION ON RELIGIOUS GROUNDS FOR FIRST RESPONDERS

RE: Religious Exemption from Immunization Requirements

I, (Legal Name), _____ the undersigned, do hereby swear and affirm that I am a member of a recognized religious organization, and that the immunizations required by (Governing Authority Name) _____ are contrary to my religious tenets and practices. On this basis, as the above referenced immunization requirements violate my right to freely exercise my religion as guaranteed by the First Amendment of the Constitution of The United States of America, I am asserting my rights to an exemption from (Governing Authority Name) _____ immunization requirements.

I qualify for this exemption based on the following:

- 1) First Amendment of the United States Constitution
- 2) First responders (i.e. law enforcement, fire department, emergency medical services) receive federal aid in the form of grants used for equipment, training, and facilities. Departments which accept federal aid must follow federal antidiscrimination laws. *42 U.S. Code § 2000a - Prohibition against discrimination or segregation in places of public accommodation*, which states “All persons shall be entitled to the full and equal enjoyment of the goods, services, facilities, privileges, advantages, and accommodations of any place of public accommodation, as defined in this section, without discrimination or segregation on the ground of race, color, religion, or national origin.”
- 3) Per the U.S. Equal Employment Opportunity Commission (EOCC) which enforces Federal laws prohibiting employment discrimination, employers MUST offer religious and disability accommodations to vaccine requirements.
- 4) COVID-19 injections have not been FDA approved. They are experimental and are only approved for “Emergency Use Authorization” (EUA). Clinical trials are ongoing and will not be completed until late 2022 and 2023, making it illegal to order anyone to get inoculated. In order for injections to be mandatory, legislation must be passed. The CDC has also noted that it is illegal and unethical to mandate EUA vaccinations.

Failure to uphold 42 U.S. Code § 2000a and any attempt to coerce an individual to get the Covid-19 vaccine at this time is a violation of federal law and may be met with legal action.
