- Parties to the arrangement: ACO WV and All ACOWV Participants Sharing Downside Risk
 - Date of arrangement: 06/06/2022
 - Items, services, goods, or facility provided: The ACO will retain the first one million dollars (\$1,000,000) in shared savings payments ("Support/Off Find") in lieu of requiring the ACO's MSSP participant practices to make payments towards shared losses payable by the ACO to CMS (downside).
 - Date and nature of any amendments to the arrangement, if applicable: ACO Retention of Shared Savings Earned in Lieu of ACO Participants Sharing in Downside Risk.
