Karen will re-apply for this grant and Mark Collins will be designated as signer on all documents. We will need resolutions for Pine & Pike. Karen will prepare for Pike Twp. to be signed at next meeting on April 2nd. Both Pike & Pine agreed to go with minimum match when applying.

Paving Projects -

Supervisors discussed needing flow study from Geo-Tech to determine whether they can shrink bridge at Kratzer Run by 4 ft. in install a box culvert.

Mark mentioned that both River Road (1.4 miles) and Douglas Rd. (1.5 miles) could use some work. They agreed to bid out both roads and then depending on the cost, pave one this year and one next year. They would have to mill out, apply base coat and then top it. A motion was made by Travis French to bid out the project and seconded by Mark Collins. Shaw Agosti from Penn Dot is coming in on Monday to look at these roads. He will provide cost information
