Riders must be 7 years old or older to participate. Camps are filled on a first come basis, so fill out your registration form and mail with your \$100 deposit to: **Whipple Tree Farm, Care Of: Dianne Gallatin, 15311 Evergreen Place, Houston, Texas 77083.**

All registration forms must arrive with a **non-refundable** \$100 deposit to reserve your spot for your desired week(s). Please **DO NOT** mail full payment, only your deposit. Your remaining balance will be collected on Day 1 of the week(s) you attend camp. All registration forms will be dated in the order they are received. If the week(s) you choose is full we will notify you and help you pick a new week(s).

We will try our best to notify you that we have received your registration, but you can also email us at whippetreefarmoftexas@gmail.com about a week after mailing your registration and deposit to confirm we have received your form.

Cancellations/Rescheduling: Deposits are non-refundable except if Whipple Tree cancels your camp week(s) for any reason. Need to change your camp week? We will do our best to reschedule you for a different week(s). Please give us one week prior notice for changes.

What To Expect At Whipple Tree Farm Summer Camp

Our special summer camp is an opportunity for your child to be exposed to a more complete picture of what owning and caring for a horse is all about. We have time during camp to show a beginner rider about:

- Tack used on horses(Bits, Saddles, Reins, etc...)
- Care of horse's feet
- Proper behavior when around horses
- What, how often and how much horses eat
- How to tie your horse properly
- The anatomy of a horse
- Care and maintenance of a horse's teeth
- How to estimate the age of a horse
- Discuss Confirmation
- Proper grooming and clipping for shows
- How to clean a horse stall
- How to clean and maintain your tack
- Practice trail riding skills(In arena)
- Practice maintaining balance in saddle
- Tacking up your own horse
- Giving a horse a bath
- Horse related arts and crafts

Camp is excellent preparation for a student who may want to begin competing at horse shows. Your child will learn a lot and have fun doing it! We hope you'll join us this year!

Overnight Camp (Must be 10 yrs old)

Are you coming to overnight camp? Here's a few things to remember to bring with you:

- Sleeping bag or mat with blanket and pillow
- Several changes of clothes
- Swimsuit and towel
- Riding helmet and boots
- Sunscreen
- Plenty of water
- Snacks(Meals are provided)
- Toiletries
- Flashlight

Overnight campers will be assigned a horse to take care of during the week. This is an adventure your child is sure to never forget! Space is limited, so register today!

Parent Information Sheet

The following information is suggested to parents in an effort to make your child's riding camp experience more enjoyable.

Hours:

Day Camp begins at 9:00 AM and ends at 3:00 PM. Weeks of June 3rd, June 17th, June 24th, July 8th, and July 15th.

Overnight Camp Begins Sunday, June 9th @ 7:00PM and runs through Friday, June 14th @ 1:00 PM.

Mini Camps Week 1- July 22nd, 23rd, and 24th. Week 2- July 29th, 30th, and 31st.

Clothes:

Long pants, jeans, baseball pants, and riding breeches are acceptable for riding. Shorts, knee-highs, and sweat pants are not recommended for riding.

Riding Helmets are required to be worn while on horseback. If you do not own a riding helmet and/or can not acquire one prior to your camp week please let Dianne know.

Riding boots are the recommended footwear for camp, but beginner riders can also wear cowboy boots or sneakers. Intermediate and advanced riders are required to have proper riding boots.

Label your child's personal items.

Sunscreen is highly recommended!

Food:

Water or Gatorade is recommended due to the Texas heat!

Lunch Boxes are recommended instead of brown bags or ziplock bags because our animals can and will eat those delicious lunches!

Charges:

Your non-refundable \$100 deposit is due with your registration form. Overnight Camp is \$750 a week. Day Camps are \$450 a week. Mini Camps are \$100 a day.

Pick-up time is 3:00-3:15 PM for all Day Camps and Mini Camps. A fee of \$25 per half hour will be charged for those who are picked up late.
