Kevin joins us from Clinton Township. He was previously an administrator for five years in Plain City after being on the village council. He also worked for the City of Dublin. Originally from Cleveland, Vaughn served as a firefighter and EMT for 12 years before moving to central Ohio.

"I really enjoy economic development and that part of the job, and Delaware County is extremely busy with economic development right now and is going to continue to be," Vaughn said in a phone interview. "I really just wanted to be a part of that and see its growth." Mr. Vaughn recently earned his certificate as a Certified Economic Developer, he is only one of 24 OCED's in the state.

"It's been an interesting time to start a new position," he said. "It's good and bad — it's good in that it gives me some time in the office to really get my feet under me and study policies, procedures, and understand our TIF (taxincrement financing) and NCA street when there is snow and remember to move basketball hoops back away from the road (new community authority) agreements, and get to know the employees. It's also difficult because it's such a community position to slowly get to know people and not be able to get out there and introduce myself."
