Greetings!

As has been the case recently, trash and recycling collection within the township is a priority concern this month.

Our contract with Republic expired January 31st, and as of February 1st Rumpke Waste & Recycling Services is the new provider township-wide. Republic is scheduled to pick up all recycling and trash containers January 31st and Feb. 1st. Due to the extreme cold temperatures it is possible those dates may



need to be extended. Call Vic Citro at 937-292-0602 if your containers are not picked up within a week.

You should have received a mailer from Rumpke with all the details about service. If you have not, please contact Rumpke as soon as possible to be sure your account is set up properly. Their number is 1-800-828-8171 and their email contact is centralohio.market@rumpke.com

The mailer which you received also has the recycling schedule on it for **your** address. **Please save the mailer so you can refer to it in the future.** Recycling is every other week.

Your first pick-up with Rumpke should occur on Thursday, February 7th, 2019. By now, you also should have received new trash and recycling containers from Rumpke. Be sure to use the Rumpke containers (or your own containers) for the February 7th pick-up date. They are not allowed to pick up trash or recycling which is in another company's container.

Salt shortage announced by County:

Berkshire Township contracts with Delaware County for road salt each year. The County has notified the township that there is an unforeseen salt shortage. Because of the shortage our Township Maintenance Department will be using a combination of salt and "grit" on all main roads. Residential neighborhoods will be salted at each intersection. The salt shortage may continue through the winter. As always, all roads will be plowed.

The Myers Inn faces Sunbury Square. Enclosed in this structure is the first one room house of Lawrence Myers which may date to 1816 (when he co-founded Sunbury) and the two story stage coach inn built by Lawrence Myers in 1820. Both frame structures were enclosed into this large building by Myers in 1825.


