While we hope no on has to use it, we now have a defibrillator for the Berkshire Township offices/meeting space. These units were installed in all 4 of the community meeting places of the municipalities that BTS&G Fire District represents. According to their website, the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States is a nonprofit Veterans service organization comprised of eligible Veterans and military service members from the active, guard and reserve forces with a mission of fostering camaraderie, service and advocacy for veterans of overseas conflicts. The organization dates as far back as 1899 when Veteran with at that time no medical care or pension banned together and formed the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States. The organizations voice has helped fight for compensation for those exposed to Agent Orange in Vietnam, diagnosed with Gulf War Syndrome and has been instrumental in getting the GI Bill approved. They have helped fund numerous monuments and begin many programs and services for Veterans and their families and communities.
