Township Highlights

Zoning Commission and Board of Zoning Appeals Openings

The Berkshire Township Zoning Commission and Board of Zoning Appeals are each apprised of five (5) members and an alternate. Members are appointed by the Township Trustees and must reside in Berkshire Township. Board positions are up for renewal every five years, on a rotating basis, in January. This means that each January there is one position on each of the boards that is up for a renewal.

The Zoning Commission typically meets once a month on the first Thursday. It reviews, interprets, upholds, and makes recommended amendments to the Zoning Code. Final say on any changes in zoning need to be approved by the Township Trustees. The Board of Zoning Appeals meets as needed on the third Wednesday of the month and is charged with hearing appeals for exceptions to the zoning code as it applies to a particular piece of property. Each member is paid \$100 per meeting attended. Serving on either of the boards is a great way to get involved in your community.

You may save a life this Holiday Season

Stress, overeating and increased alcohol are top contributors to strokes and the holidays are full of those and other top contributing factors. Reviewing warning signs and being aware can save a life.

F.A.S.T. Warning Signs to spot a STROKE

Use the letters in F.A.S.T. to spot a Stroke

- F = Face Drooping – Does one side of the face droop or is it numb? Ask the person to smile. Is the person's smile uneven?
- A = Arm Weakness – Is one arm weak or numb? Ask the person to raise both arms. Does one arm drift downward?
- S = Speech Difficulty – Is speech slurred?
- T = Time to call 911 – Stroke is an emergency. Every minute counts. Call 911 immediately. Note the time when any of the symptoms first appear.
