Sales Tax Holiday

Ohio will have a Sales Tax Holiday running from Friday, August 6, 2021 at 12:00 a.m. to Sunday, August 8, 2021 at 11:59 p.m.

During the holiday, the following items are exempt from sales and use tax:

- ☐ Clothing priced at \$75 or less
- ☐ School supplies or Instructional materials priced at \$20 or less

Rumpke contract renewed

During the July 12th Trustee Meeting it was voted to renew the contract for collection, transfer and disposal of solid wastes with Rumpke of Ohio at a 3% increase. This contract will be effective as of February 1, 2022

Zoning - Be in the Know

"Why do I need a zoning certificate to put a deck in my back yard on my property?"

As we continue to get many questions about the rules and regulations, we want to help clarify. Most people want to do things right and we appreciate that.

The purpose of the permitting process is verifying that the deck is being built outside of the right of ways, utility easements, and setback requirements. We do not want your neighbor to put his party platform 1 foot from your property line. Rules are put in place for both your protection and your neighbors. These regulations help protect your property values.

If you plan on putting a patio or deck on your property, the application is available on the township website under the Zoning tab.

Keep up to date

We have issued 163 permits for new homes and condos in 2021.

The township is currently in the process of reviewing our zoning code for some possible changes. We meet the first Thursday of each month. These are public meetings. You can stay updated with meetings, agendas and minutes by referring to our website.
