
Township Highlights

Understanding Zoning Terminology

This ran a couple years ago and is worth repeating.

When filling out any of basic zoning applications you may run across terms that are not that familiar. Likewise, when you call in regarding certain road issues terms get referenced that may be confusing. Here are a few terms clarified:

Right-of Way - Corridors of land of varying dimensions (typically 30 - 150 wide) that accommodate civil services such as electric lines or storm drains.

Easement - A legal agreement with a landowner that permits access to the property. This may be to construct and operate facilities.

Easements and right-of-way are property rights, and recorded easement agreements are part of the effected real estate's title. Most are perpetual meaning they affect and apply to the new owner when a property is sold and transferred. Individuals should review these items before purchasing property or deciding to construct on their current property.

According to the Delaware County Engineer's website. "**Delaware County requires that any person, contractor, agency, company, utility, etc. wishing to perform work of any kind within the public right-of-way (R/W) of Delaware County and Township roads or easements obtain a permit before performing the work. This shall include the installation of driveways, drive pipes, the construction or reconstruction of road ditches, the installation or repair of utilities, road closures, etc, and/or occupying said right-of-way or easements for any purpose whatsoever**"

Last year's Delaware County Roads Construction Guide highlighted three projects on the horizon within Berkshire Township.

First up Rome Corners and Dustin Road intersection where a new single-lane roundabout with drainage upgrades is expected to take place. Updated scheduling shows utility relocation in 2026 and actual construction now scheduled for 2027.

There will be three roundabouts across Cheshire Road. The first two are expected in 2027 and include South Galena/Rome Corners 5 point intersection and Golf Course Road including Millstone Drive. The third which will be at Africa Road is still undetermined as to its construction schedule.

It's Tax Season

Filing you 2025 Tax forms

January 31st is the typical deadline for receiving your tax documents. If you haven't receive your appropriate forms by now, check to see if they are available on line or contact your employer or financial institution to inquire.

Your Delaware County District Library locations provide federal, state, municipal, and school district tax forms as needed on demand. Library staff can find the forms, print them, and print instructions, but cannot provide any advice on how to fill them out. The first copy of any tax form is printed for patrons free of charge, and the first 10 pages of printed instructions will be offered for free. Locally the Community Library has two by appointment help sessions scheduled for Friday, February 6th and Friday February 20th 9am-5pm. Check other area County Libraries for other available dates. Berkshire Township does not have an income tax

While Berkshire Township does not have an income tax, it does have two Joint Economic Development Districts (JEDDs). A JEDD is an agreement with a municipality and a township that allows the township to administer the municipality's income tax over a designated area. The portion of this income tax the Township receives helps pay for the public infrastructure of the immediate area surrounding your development along with other needed capital expenditures. The City of




