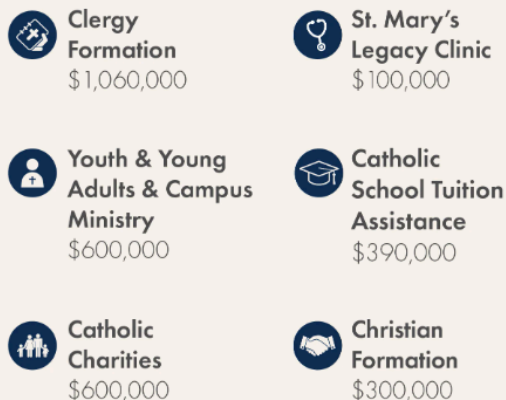

Attention Parents with Children in Religious Education

In order to prepare for the completion of sacramental preparation classes and the reception of First Holy Communion and Confirmation, we are now collecting all baptismal certificates. This is required for your child to receive their sacraments. We need an original copy of your child's baptismal certificate with notations of all the other sacraments they have received (if applicable) from their place of baptism. The certificate needs to have been made in the past 6 months. If Holy Cross is not your child's place of baptism, simply reach out to that Parish and ask them to send it to us directly through the mail. Our address is on the front page of the bulletin. If Holy Cross is your child's place of baptism, please reach out to the Parish Office and let us know so we can create your baptismal certificates. If your child is not yet baptized, please reach out to the Parish Office to schedule their baptism. It is a joy to accomodate your family's sacramental life!

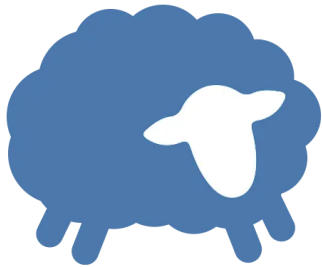
Grades 9-12 meeting on Tuesdays from 6-8pm in the Family Life Room. All high school and soon to be high school students are welcomed to attend.

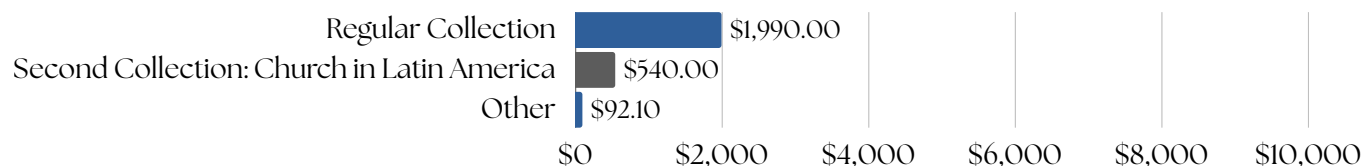

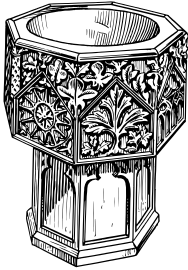

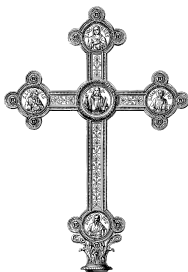

Catholic Faith Formation Classes

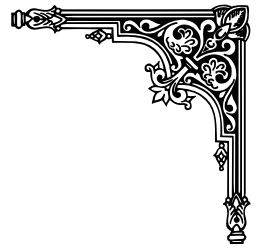
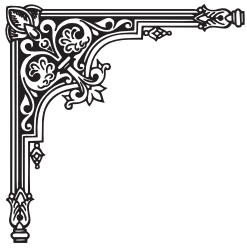
