Recalling that praying for the living and the dead is one of the seven spiritual works of mercy, let us pray for one another.

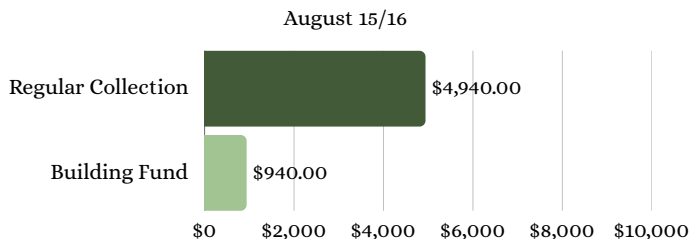

Catholic Faith Formation Classes Clases de Formación en la Fe Católica

It's time to register for Holy Cross Catholic Faith Formation Classes! CFFC registration for grades K-12 begins on **Saturday, August 15, 2026** and the deadline for registration is **Wednesday, September 30, 2026**. Classes begin on **Wednesday, September 9, 2026 at 6:30-7:30pm**. The Calendar is posted on our website. If Sevier County schools are closed for inclement weather or illness, CFFC is not automatically cancelled. The Parish Office will communicate when classes are cancelled.

In order to register for CFFC, there are **two** requirements:

First, the family **MUST** either:

- a) register as parishioners and receive a *Family ID#*, or
- b) update their parish registration on our website using their existing *Family ID#*. If your family is already registered and uses OSV Sunday Envelopes for donations, you can find your *Family ID#* on the outside of your weekly envelopes. CFFC Teachers are available after each Saturday & Sunday Mass until September 6 in the Family Life Room to help families find their *Family ID#* from the parish database system.

Second, the family **MUST** register their child using the *CFFC JotForm* on our website using their *Family ID#*. Note that all the information with an *asterisk* **MUST** be completed, and that a child is not registered for CFFC until BOTH the family parish registration information and the CFFC JotForm are accurately completed and you receive a confirmation email.

Securing these **two registrations** makes possible the accurate administrative processing of sacramental records for years to come. Thank you for your cooperation!

*¡Es hora de inscribirse en las Clases de Formación en la Fe Católica (CFFC) de Holy Cross! La inscripción en CFFC para los grados K-12 comienza el **sábado 15 de agosto de 2026** y la fecha límite para inscribirse es el **miércoles 30 de septiembre de 2026**. Las clases comienzan el **miércoles 9 de septiembre de 2026 de 6:30 a 7:30 p.m.** El calendario está publicado a continuación. Si las escuelas del Condado de Sevier cierran por mal tiempo o enfermedad, la CFFC no se cancela automáticamente. La Oficina Parroquial comunicará cuando las clases sean canceladas.*

Para inscribirse en la CFFC, hay **dos** requisitos:

Primero, la familia **DEBE**:

- a) inscribirse como feligreses y recibir un Número de ID Familiar, o
- b) actualizar su registro parroquial en nuestro sitio web utilizando su Número de ID Familiar existente. Si su familia ya está registrada y utiliza los sobres dominicales de OSV para sus donaciones, puede encontrar su Número de ID Familiar en el exterior de sus sobres semanales. Los maestros de CFFC estarán disponibles después de cada misa de sábado y domingo hasta el 6 de septiembre en la Salón de Vida Familiar (Family Life Room) para ayudar a las familias a encontrar su Número de ID Familiar en el sistema de base de datos de la parroquia.

Segundo, la familia **DEBE** inscribir a su hijo utilizando el formulario JotForm de CFFC en nuestro sitio web utilizando su Número de ID Familiar. Tenga en cuenta que toda la información marcada con un asterisco **DEBE** completarse, y que un niño no queda inscrito en la CFFC hasta que **AMBOS** registros —la información de registro parroquial de la familia y el JotForm de CFFC— estén completados correctamente y usted reciba un correo electrónico de confirmación.

Asegurar estos dos registros hace posible el procesamiento administrativo preciso de los registros sacramentales en los años venideros. ¡Gracias por su cooperación!
