Before the new hires, there was one Office Manager position, which has now been divided into two positions: Secretary and Resource Manager.

Our parish secretary, Rebekah Snyder, serves as receptionist to receive general questions about Mass times and intentions, parish events, sacramental records and blessings, parish registration, and meetings with me, as well as bulletin and pulpit announcements. If you would like an announcement in the bulletin or from the pulpit, please submit the text of the announcement to her via **email by 12 PM on Wednesdays** to be included in the Sunday bulletin or pulpit announcements.

Our resource manager, Michael Landree, serves to organize maintenance, security, personnel including volunteers, and gift shop needs. He handles purchasing of materials and supplies, invoices, contracts, projects, policies, reimbursements, Safe Environment and insurance paperwork. All three of us (myself included) are learning our roles together as we attend diocesan meetings or read diocesan policies and guidelines. Please be patient with us as we learn and grow together to serve you better. What a grace to be a humble coworker in the vineyard of Christ, and a servant of all!
