

The Wake Forest Alano Club, Inc, (WAC) is a non-profit 501(c)(3) (tax ID 26-1698497) organization serving Wake Forest, Youngsville, Rolesville and the surrounding communities.

Since 2007, it has provided a safe space for people suffering with substance use disorder, and other 12-step programs to meet and socialize. The WAC is a crucial resource to the local recovery community offering more than a dozen meetings weekly.

The WAC has no paid staff and is managed by volunteers from the community it serves. During the first 12 months of the \$200,000 Capital Campaign, the WAC received 134 donations from 72 individuals and businesses totaling \$143,767. This allowed us to pay off the \$137,000 balance on our mortgage on September 17, 2024. This saved the WAC over \$105,000 in interest payments and reduced the WAC's monthly costs by \$1,208.

Now it is time to finish the work! We will officially kick off the second phase of the Capital Campaign on Saturday October 12, 2024, at 6 pm at the WAC, to begin a three month push to raise the remaining funds need to establish a \$50,000 capital reserve.

Nonprofits organizations owning a building need to maintain a capital reserve to cover future capital costs. Over time all buildings need to replace heat and air conditioning systems, roofs, windows and make general overall improvements to maintain the value of the property.

We cannot do it alone. As the communities we serve are growing rapidly, so is the need for this resource. We are thrilled to be able to provide it and are passionate about carrying the message of hope forward to other people suffering from substance use disorder.
