




# MULTI-TIERED SYSTEM OF SUPPORTS: LITERACY



### 1 - SCREENING

- Administer the Degrees of Reading Power (DRP), i-Ready, or MAP Growth assessment
- Administer secondary screeners (Word Identification Spelling Test, Test of Silent Word Reading Fluency, and Oral Reading Fluency) to underserved students

# 2 - IDENTIFYING SUPPORTS

- Align the supports that students need with Tier 1 instruction.
- Meet with your school literacy team and MSQI coach to select the appropriate <u>intervention program</u> or enrichment for students.

# **3-PLANNING SUPPORT**

- Register for intervention professional learning,
- Design a coaching cycle aligning Tier 1 instruction to student literacy needs based on screener data,
- Meet with teacher leaders to plan for classroom visits and model lessons

# 4 - IMPLEMENTING SUPPORTS

- Schedule intervention and enrichment classes 3-5x/week
- Teachers plan for instruction:
  - o write lesson plans daily for programs with guided curriculum;
  - prepare materials in advance for scripted programs
- Teachers implement the Tier 2 and/or 3 program with fidelity

### **5 - PROGRESS MONITORING**

- Monitor classroom instruction using the <u>Adolescent Literacy Intervention Walk-</u>
   <u>Through Tool</u>
- Monitor student progress using tools built-in to programs.
- Monitor student progress and equity of voice using the **3-2-1 Tool**
- Intervention teachers share student data and teaching support with Tier 1 teachers

### **6 - EVALUATING OUTCOMES**

- Continue to measure student outcomes using mid and end-of-year screening data
- Analyze student outcomes using tools built-in to intervention programs
