<u>Note 2:</u> Swimming WA annual fee, attract a Discount for 3rd swimmer - 30%, 4th swimmer - 50%, 5th swimmer - 80%, 6th swimmer – FREE

Note 3: AKSC club fees are discounted for 2nd and 3rd swimmers.

<u>Note 4:</u> Age of Member and category is based on the age at 1 October 2022 or at the time of Membership purchase for the 2022/23 season, whichever is the latter.

<u>Note 5:</u> Discounts apply for families with 3 or more swimmers in a Swimming WA affiliated Club and apply to the Membership with least value. Only one discount can be applied per Member.

Note 6: If a swimmer has trained or been registered with another club in the previous 3 years a transfer form and fee is required to be paid directly to swimming WA - \$25.

Note 7: If a swimmer is U18 they will be required to have one parent or guardian signed up as a member

Note 8: Swimmers please arrive 15min prior to your session to do stretching, warm-up.

Note 9: All swimmers aged 10 years and under must have a parent/guardian hand over to our coaches and pick them up at the end of their session (they must be supervised at the pool when not training). This is a requirement of the Armadale Aquatic Centre. You cannot drop them off at the front and let them walk into the Centre unaccompanied.

Note 10: Fitness squad is open to swimmers 12 years and over (must have intermediate squad or above ability).

- Goggles (compulsory)
- Swimming cap (compulsory)*
- Kick board (compulsory)**
- Flippers/fins (flexible rubbery type) (compulsory)
- Water bottle
- Towel
- Pool buoy (Senior/State Development swimmers only)
- Hand paddles (Senior/State Development swimmers only)
- * New members will receive an AKSC swimming cap once fully registered.
- ** The club has kickboards members can borrow during training until they purchase their own.
