

COSTUME FUND:

The costume fund is available for those wishing to participate in the 2026 Concert. An amount of your choice is collected throughout the year (weekly, fortnightly or monthly) to go towards costumes for your child/children like a "layby" system. Allow approximately \$60.00 - \$75.00 per dance item, additional costs will be invoiced if required and refunds will be issued if the full amount is not completely used. The costume fund is not compulsory, however **money for purchase of all costumes must be in by the end of Term 2 or costumes will not be purchased.** If a costume has to be made there will be additional dressmaking fees.

EXAMINATIONS:

Exams are not compulsory, I will advise if the student/s are ready to take part in exams. Tap exams will be held at the end of Term 2. Ballet exam dates will be advised once confirmed with the RAD.

2026 CONCERT INFORMATION PLEASE MAKE THE FOLLOWING DATES AVAILABLE

DRESS REHEARSAL: (Compulsory Attendance)

Dress rehearsal will be held on Saturday, 31st October 2026 at the studio. Students will perform in their full costumes only, Hair done & no make up required.

PHOTOSHOOT: (Compulsory Attendance)

The photo shoot will be held on Saturday, 7th November 2026 at the studio. Students have photos taken in full costume and make-up and hair to be done, single and group shots.

STAGE REHEARSAL: (Compulsory Attendance)

The stage rehearsals will be held at the Cessnock Performing Arts Centre on 24/11/26 & 25/11/26.

CONCERT REHEARSAL:

Extra Term 4 concert rehearsals will be held at normal class venues in normal class times, only if needed. I will advise if this is necessary for your child / children. There will be a "concert run" prior to the concert performance. Please ensure you make these dates available.

CONCERT PERFORMANCE:

The end of year concert will be held in Term 4, at the Performing Arts Centre (Vincent Street, Cessnock) on Saturday, 28th November 2026. Again this is not compulsory however; if you do not wish for your child to participate in the concert please advise me as soon as possible before costumes are purchased.



2026 GENERAL INFORMATION:

Welcome to all students and parents.

ADC offers tuition in Tap, Jazz, Hip Hop, Ballet, Lyrical / Contemporary, Yoga, ACRO, Tiny Tots, adults classes and Dance Ability. Concert, Eisteddfod, Exam or "Just for Fun" classes are available for beginners to pre-professional students and adults.

LOCATION:

Classes are held at the following venue.

UNIFORM:

Class uniform is as follows (**Uniform is compulsory**)

Uniforms can be purchased / ordered at reception.

- **Boys: To be purchased at studio.**
Black shorts, black pants, black singlet or black t-shirt and appropriate footwear for the dance style
BLACK tap shoes / jazz shoes
- **Girls: Uniforms to be purchased at studio.**
Black dancepants, black danceshorts, black tights, black skirt, black singlet or black leotard and appropriate footwear for the dance style.
Ballet students **MUST** wear a leotard and stockings. **Tan tap shoes junior school, Black Tap shoes senior school**
Hair is to be neatly groomed (pulled back off face in a bun or ponytail only, please do not wear hair "out", this is inappropriate for dance.)

- Registration/Enrolment Fees are to be paid prior to commencement of classes, students will be unable to participate unless registration fees are paid.

- Please note outstanding fees at the end of each month will incur an administration charge of \$25 per month if the balance is not paid by the conclusion of the month.
- **ALL LESSONS MISSED MUST BE PAID FOR UNLESS CANCELLED BY THE TEACHER – NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- Cash, direct deposit and direct debit accepted. Card facilities are also available at reception desk.
- CASH: Please place all fees in an envelope with name, date and amount listed and pass to administration staff or your teacher at the beginning of each of your lessons.
- All term accounts must be paid in full by the end of week 2 each term.
- Weekly fees are to be paid in advance i.e. Week 1 & 2 must be paid Week 1, Week 3 & 4 must be paid Week 3, Week 5 & 6 must be paid Week 5, Week 7 & 8 must be paid Week 7 and Week 9 & 10 must be paid Week 9.
- IF FEES ARE OVERDUE STUDENTS WILL BE UNABLE TO PARTICIPATE IN CLASSES UNTIL FEES ARE PAID IN FULL.
- Any fees incurred from direct debit dishonour will be charged back to the student.



STUDIO RULES & POLICIES (Summary):

- Please ensure student/s arrive 5 minutes prior to commencement of lesson/s, lateness causes disruption to the class in progress.
- Please ensure students are dressed appropriately for dance lessons. (No boardshorts, jeans, baggy shirts etc)
- Parents are **NOT** permitted to stay in the studio whilst classes are in progress please wait outside, except in toddler classes where parents are able to participate.
- Please note; if you need to speak about your child's progress please remember that we need to keep to a strict time regime. If you need to discuss anything in depth, please feel free to contact me via email only. I will contact you after classes are finished for the night or at a suitable time.
- Parent/guardian's are responsible for their child's/ children's behaviour and safety at all times; this includes the parking area, toilets, foyer and studio. **THERE IS STRICTLY – NO RUNNING OR MISBEHAVING ON THE PREMISES.**
- Students are not permitted in the classrooms when not participating in the class that is in progress.
- Whilst classes are in progress, noise levels must be kept to a minimum at all times.
- All students must be collected from the reception area of the premises, no-one is to wait outside.
- All lessons missed must be paid for unless cancelled by the teacher. Places are made available in classes for students, these classes must be paid for whether the student attends or not.
- Two weeks notice is required prior to terminating lessons and fees must be finalised before termination.

- **ALL STUDENTS WISHING TO PERFORM ADC ROUTINES (OF ANY KIND) ARE TO HAVE MY PERSONAL PERMISSION PRIOR TO THE PERFORMANCE / DEMONSTRATION. (DOCUMENTATION WILL BE REQUIRED)**
