- D. Legislative: Tom Herrin reported that the CLSA Board of Directors were asked to get feedback on the following:
  - Proposing additional language for PLS Act Section 8761(g) which will state that all Records of Survey be filed directly with County Recorder without County Surveyor examination.
  - Amending PLS Act Section 8766.5 for the Record of Survey examination fee to be fixed at \$500 for the first sheet and \$250 for each additional sheet.
  - Reintroducing AB 1855 (2014), was introduced, Melendez, to show easements on Record of Survey.
