AB3176, an act to amend section 8773.3 of the Business and Professions Code, relating to land surveying, died in committee, but moved to AB3253, a BPELSG sunset bill.

AB3253, An act to amend Sections 130, 6710, 6711, 6713, 6714, 6738, 6749, 6755, 6755.1, 6763.5, 6787, 7839.2, 7872, 8710, 8729, 8748.5, 8759, 8773.3, and 8792 of, and to add and repeal Section 8771.6 of, the Business and Professions Code, relating to professions and vocations.

At the last CLSA Board of Directors, they approved the following motions to move forwarding to the next legislative session in 2025

- 8765, map checking fee exemption for public agencies
- 8766, clarify language on map checking return after 20 working days
- 8764.5, adding back date on the signature block
- 8772, tagging monuments
- 8766, adding language to ensure returning the checked maps to the submitting licensed surveyor
