- I. Call to Order: Call to Order at 10:26am by David Bush.
- II. Approval of Minutes – January Minutes approved with revisions. David Bush to make revisions and upload the revised Minutes to the website.
- III. Treasurer’s Report – Marcellino Miller – No report. Not present.

 - B. GIS Mapping Systems – Ryan Hunsicker – No report. Not present. Sam Ochoa, San Bernardino County, went to the Urisa conference in January at the ESRI Campus. He was surprised to hear how much the gis people are trying to learn about surveying. Lots of do’s and don’t’s about surveying.
 - C. GPS\CORS\CSRC – Greg Helmer – He has been working on SCIP application. Only place to get coordinates in a different datum. NGS has not published new coordinates yet. CSRC has a meeting coming up with NGS about the deformation model.
 - D. Legislative – Dan Walsh gave the report. At the State CLSA Board Meeting February 7, 2026, nothing going on really. A few items are trying to get into bills. Unlicensed survey work trying to get to a bill. Lots of push back from contractors. CLSA is still pushing to get Record of Survey redlines to go to the surveyor of record. CLSA is trying to get some additional wording in the LS Act. CLSA would add that the County Surveyor needs to check for un-tagged monuments on Corner Records. David Farrell said he doesn’t have staff to check the Corner Records for un-tagged monuments. David Bush added that that is something Orange County is already doing. Debbie Naves added that years ago there was an opinion from the Board about this issue, but she couldn’t remember the details. Caltrans having problems getting Record of Surveys reviewed and recorded. Caltrans says they don’t need to pay for a review and the counties won’t review without payment. Lots of discussion. Lot Line Adjustments are being looking at again by the Legislative Committee.
