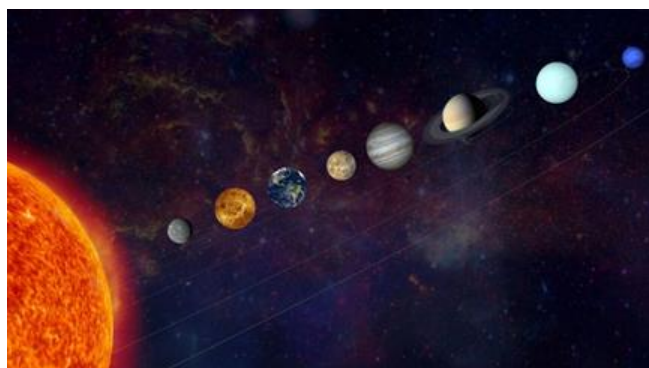




# Align Your Leadership Universe
