

CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS

ARTICLE I NAME

This organization shall be known as Laguna Woods Men's Golf Club (18 Hole), hereinafter referred to as the "Club".

ARTICLE II PURPOSE

The Laguna Woods Men's Golf Club provides its members with opportunities for pleasure, recreation, and social relationships. Contributions made by the Club membership to charitable organizations help support those in our community who are in need. The Club takes a leadership role in representing the golfing community in Laguna Woods Village.

ARTICLE III MEMBERSHIP

- A. Membership is open to all male residents who own and occupy a manor in Laguna Woods Village or who are lessees and who are 55 years of age or older. Applicants shall be accepted upon submission of membership application and required fee.
- B. The Club shall maintain membership in both the Southern California and United States Golf Associations. Regular Membership includes membership in the Southern California Golf Association (SCGA).
- C. Associate Membership is available to those who wish to participate in Club activities except golf events requiring a Handicap Index at Laguna Woods Golf Course. Application for Associate Membership is open as described in Article III A. Associate Members are not afforded membership in SCGA through LWMGC. Associate Members are subject to the same rules and regulations as regular members.

- D. Annual dues shall be determined by the Club's Board of Directors (hereinafter referred to as "The Board") for the upcoming year. Payment of renewal dues are due on or before your renewal date, which is located on the club's website Payments can be made online, through the Men's Club Website Iwmgc.org. Renewal dues received after your annual renewal date will be considered delinquent and processed as reinstatements. Reinstatements are charged a \$15 fee. Failure to renew membership shall result in loss of SCGA membership and handicap index without prejudice to rejoin as a reinstated member.
- E. Handicap Indices: Membership itself does not necessarily guarantee eligibility to compete in club sponsored tournaments. (For additional requirements see Tournament Rules section of the Membership Manual) Such eligibility shall be based upon any one of the following:
 - 1. A current SCGA/GHIN Handicap Index.
 - An Initial Handicap Index based on three (3) or more eighteen (18) hole rounds of golf or fiftyfour (54) holes of golf in any combination of nine (9) or eighteen (18) holes of Posted Scores.

Handicap Indices are automatically calculated by SCGA/GHIN and are based on a minimum of three (3) or more eighteen (18) hole rounds of golf or fifty-four (54) holes of golf in any combination of nine (9) or eighteen (18) hole Posted Scores. A complete score file consists of twenty (20) eighteen (18) hole rounds played at member clubs in any nine (9) or eighteen (18) hole combination of rounds of Posted Scores. It is the responsibility of each member to post their adjusted score of all eighteen (18) and nine (9) hole rounds of golf using any of the following methods to Post; the

GHIN mobile App; SCGA.org website; USGA.org website; the Club's Posting Computer located outside the Pro Shop or the GHIN link on the club's website. Current handicap indices of all members shall be available by searching by GHIN number on the GHIN mobile App; at the SCGA.org website; USGA.org website; the Club Posting Computer located outside the Pro Shop. Club Member's Handicap Index will be posted online at **lwmgc.org**.

- F. Any member who commits an act which discredits the Club or brings it into disrepute, or who fails to comply with its rules and regulations shall be subject to suspension or expulsion by a vote of two-thirds of the Board after a ten (10) day written notice and an opportunity to be heard.
- G. By a majority vote of the Board, membership may be conferred on those they feel have contributed to the advancement of the club's interests. Payment of the SCGA fee will be the responsibility of the individual unless voted otherwise by the Board.

ARTICLE IV MEETINGS

Regular meetings of the Club shall be held in the months of January, March, April, June, August, and October on the fourth (4th) Tuesday of the month. The meeting in October shall be the "Annual" meeting. The location of the Annual and all regular meetings shall be held at Clubhouse 2. Any change to this location will be communicated to the membership well in advance of the meeting date. Those members present at any meeting shall constitute a quorum to conduct the business of the Club.

ARTICLE V DIRECTORS AND OFFICERS

A. Board of Directors:

The Club shall be governed by a Board of eleven (11) directors and the past President.

B. Officers and their Duties:

President: The President shall preside over the General Membership Meeting's and the monthly Board Meetings. In the name of the Club, the President is authorized to sign all written contracts and obligations of the club and shall be an authorized signer on all bank accounts. He is an Ex Officio member of all committees (except the nominating committee and the audit committee). He shall attend the Monthly Meeting of the Greens Committee and put forth the views of the Club. He shall represent the Club in all matters and at all external functions. He or his designate shall be responsible for preparing and publishing the annual Membership Manual and Calendar in time for the January membership meeting. The President may appoint additional members to attend the Greens Committee Meeting to ensure that 2 voting members are present at each meeting. He or his designate will coordinate the creation of an Annual President's Ball to be held on a date and location in January that a majority of the Board agrees upon.

Vice President: The Vice President shall assume all duties of the President in his absence. He shall assist the President as requested by the President. He shall be chairman of at least one of the Club's committees. He will be an authorized signer on all bank accounts.

Secretary: The Secretary assumes all duties of the President in the absence of both the President and the Vice President. He shall take the minutes of all Club and Board meetings and shall post these minutes in an

appropriate place for review by the membership. He shall report these minutes at the next meeting. He shall assist the President as requested. He has the responsibility of keeping the Club's perpetual trophies and individual recognition awards up-to-date and engraved with the names of the current year's event winners.

The Treasurer is responsible for the Treasurer: collection and distribution of the Club's money and is authorized to sign all checks and/or withdrawals on all deposit accounts in the name of the Club. In this capacity, he is an Ex Officio member of all committees in which money is collected or paid out. He shall present the results of the previous month's financial activity at the monthly Board Meetings. Upon approval of the Board these monthly statements shall be posted in appropriate place for review by the general membership. At the August Board Meeting he shall provide a suggested budget to include any required changes in members' dues for the following year. He shall keep the financial records in good order and comply with IRS reporting requirements. He shall also have responsibility for Club contributions given to a Board-approved charitable organization in memory of deceased members.

C. Composition of the Board:

The Members of the Board shall consist of four Officers, the President, Vice President, Secretary, and the Treasurer, and seven additional members from the club membership as Directors. In addition, the immediate Past President shall continue automatically as an advisor to the President for a term of one year. He shall serve to create continuity and tradition on the Board and in the Club. He may recommend changes to the Constitution and the By- Laws to the Board, as they are warranted.

Each member is elected to serve a three-year term on the Board.

Any member of the Club, as well as the members of the current Board are eligible, at the general election, to run for the Board. Each year at the October General Membership Meeting, new members shall be elected, by a majority show of hands vote, replacing the same number of vacancies anticipated for next year's Board.

D. Election of Board Members:

At least ten weeks prior to the Annual (October) Meeting, the President, with consent and approval of the Board shall appoint a Nominating Committee consisting of a Chairman and up to four members. The Nominating Committee shall submit a slate of at least the number of candidates as there are Board vacancies, to the Board by the September Board meeting. This list of candidates, with their proposed term of office for each candidate listed, shall be communicated to the General Membership electronically via e-mail and posted on the Club's website prior to the October General Membership Meeting.

Nominations may also be made by petition signed by at least twenty-five members. Such petitions shall be delivered to the Secretary at least two weeks prior to the Annual (October) Meeting. The membership shall cast their vote by ballot, if contested, at the Club's Annual Meeting. The President shall appoint a committee of three members who are not candidates, to supervise the election and count the votes. The candidates for Director receiving the highest number of votes from those present shall be elected to the Board.

E. Financial Limitation:

No Officer, Director, or Committee Member may obligate the Club to an amount more than one hundred dollars (\$100) without the approval of the Board of Directors. Event chairmen, however, may spend as indicated in their approved budget. All expenditures or withdrawals more than five hundred dollars (\$500) will require two authorized signatures, or prior approval by the Board of Directors.

F. Board Vacancy:

In the event of a vacancy on the Board, the Board shall convene as soon as possible and by majority vote, elect a successor to fill the uncompleted term. Any former Board member is eligible to be appointed to fill that vacancy by the President, with Board approval. Should no past Board member accept the open position the President may recommend any Club member, in good standing, to the Board for their approval.

In the event the President is unable to continue to fulfill his duties, the Vice President shall become "President" for the remainder of the term. The Board shall elect a residing Board member to serve as "Vice President".

G. Board Perks:

Residing board members and Past President's do not pay entry fees for Major tournaments. All Board members and Past President's pay their own Greens Fees and or Cart Fees.

If you are on the Board when your membership comes due, your membership for the next year is paid by the Club. Past presidents are granted lifetime, paid membership.

ARTICLE VI FUNCTIONS

- A. The Secretary shall convene all eleven members of the new Board for the purpose of electing the President. He will then call for nominations, and if there is only one candidate, he will be declared President by unanimous consent. If there are multiple candidates, a vote by secret ballot will be held. The candidate who receives at least six (6) votes (a quorum) will be declared the new President. The results of this election shall be communicated to the General Membership electronically via e-mail and posted on the Club website prior to the January General Membership meeting. The President shall appoint a Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer. All officers and directors shall then assume their duties on January 1st of the year following their election.
- A. The Board shall meet at such time and place as they may decide. A majority of the Board shall constitute a quorum for any Board meeting.
- D. The President shall define the power and duties of all committees. The President who will be an Ex Officio member of all committees, except the Nominating Committee and the Audit Committee, shall approve all committee chairmen and members.

The following Committees and Chairmen shall be appointed each year to:

Major Tournament Committee: Schedule and manage monthly Major Tournaments

Regular Wednesday Play Committee:Schedule and manage Regular Wednesday Play and Open Play.

Flight Tournament Committee: Schedule and manage Flight Tournaments

Handicap, Membership & Orientation Committee: Establish fair and proper handicaps consistent with SCGA rules and procedures, shall be responsible for processing memberships, maintaining a current club roster, and direct new member orientation. The Handicap Chairman shall serve as the Club's delegate to the SCGA.

Special Events Committee: This Chairman's duties are to Organize and manage the Memorial Tournament, Member-Guest Tournament, the annual Volunteer Appreciation Luncheon and by mutual agreement, any other designated "special event" that does not fall under the responsibility of another committee chairman.

Sponsorship Committee: This Chairman's duties shall be to plan and direct the Club's Sponsorship Program with Board oversight. This will primarily involve contacting local business establishments to obtain financial sponsorship for the Club. By working jointly with the business sponsors and the Board of Directors, the Chairman will develop and implement a program mutually beneficial to the Club and Business Sponsors. The Chairman will Schedule speakers and entertainment at membership meetings.

Competitions Committee: Promote interest in SCGA competitions and other tournaments between Golf Clubs. To publicize opportunities for participation in SCGA Team Play and other SCGA tournaments, Silver Senior League Play, Home/Away Tournaments, the College match, and other competitions that may be developed. The Competitions Committee will be appointed annually by the President, at least 60 days prior to July 1st with approval of the Board. The Competitions Committee will appoint Team Captains annually, select and assign players to specific teams, arrange for Club House reservations, and make

other arrangements as required by the competitions. The term of office for the Competitions Committee and Team Captains shall be from July 1 through June 30.

Greens and Rules Committee: Cooperate with course management, to supervise play and ensure its consistency with SCGA and USGA rules, and to recommend to the Board an appropriate system of local course rules. Also, to cooperate with the Handicap Committee in improving all course conditions, control over such features as boundaries, tee markers, cart paths, etc.

Constitution and By-Laws Committee: Maintain and keep current the Constitution and By-Laws of the Club. To ensure that proper compliance to the methods and rules for communicating changes and amendments to the document are followed.

Social Committee: The Chairman shall monitor and report on the health of the membership to the Board and provide supportive actions.

Additional Contests Committee: Shall act as a liaison between the Board and the representatives of recurring weekly or monthly Club competitions such as the Tuesday Team Scramble, Putting Contest, Par 3 Tournament, and the Derby.

Information Technology (IT) Committee: This

The Committee has the responsibility to ensure that our Club's computer system, software and access to the Club's electronic data are secure and under control. The Committee shall also keep all required HW & SW licenses up to date and properly functioning.

Fairways & Green's Committee: Under the supervision of the Club President, the Fairways & Green's Coordinator writes, recruits, and assists volunteer writers for the column. Such assistance shall include suggestions of topics and scheduling of articles. He communicates with the Club President, the writers, and the Globe's Editor to ensure that articles are timely, interesting, informative to members, and depict a positive, constructive portrayal of Club activities and Club members. The coordinator shall submit these articles to the President for review before they are submitted for publication, and edit as necessary for clarity, brevity, and grammar.

Document Control & Records Management Focal:

This position assures that all documents and data stored, displayed, and managed from the LWMGC server/computer(s) are current, correct and traceable. This position also includes membership and active participation on the Information Technology (IT) Committee to ensure proper methods and process discipline are followed to meet the needs of the Board.

Historian: Club Historian(s) maintain the written and pictorial history of the Club...which includes but is not limited to...its accomplishments, events held, documents published, Past Presidents and Past Club Champions bio's etc. Each year, the historian will coordinate with the outgoing President to collect a summary of the Board and the Club's highlights and achievements for this record. He shall also maintain the on-line InMemoriam Plaque.

The InMemoriam Plaque Policy: To be considered for placement on the online InMemoriam plaque a member must meet one of the following criteria:

- Current or past Club member in good standing.
- Significant contribution to the function and purpose of the Club.

Audit Committee: The President, with the consent and approval of the Board, shall appoint an independent Audit Committee to audit the Treasurer's books, the financial records of the Major Tournament Chairman, and any other Tournament(s) which is deemed necessary. The Annual Audit shall be conducted prior to December 31st.

ARTICLE VII PROCEDURE

Roberts Rules of Order shall govern the conduct of club meetings except as they may conflict with these by-laws.

ARTICLE VIII AMENDMENTS

This Constitution and By-Laws may, upon recommendation of the Board, be amended by two-thirds of the membership present at any General Membership meeting. Amendments shall be presented to Club membership at a General Membership meeting one month prior to the vote and communicated to the General Membership electronically via e-mail, posted on the Club website and posted on the Club bulletin board for that month. Proposed changes shall be voted on at the next General Membership meeting and, if approved, take effect immediately.

LWMGC FLIGHT CUP SERIES

The Flight Cup Series is a year-long series of 7 flighted events using Individual Stroke Play. Stableford Point Scoring System is used to determine order of finish, culminating with a 2-round playoff to determine the Cup Championship.

The Flight Cup Series is modeled after the PGA Fedex Cup. Players will be awarded bonus points based on their season long performance.

The participants' handicap for each event will be established by using their current LWMGC USGA/GHIN index. Once assigned to a flight each member will remain in that flight throughout the LWMGC Flight Cup Series season.

A member's January Index is used to place a player in a flight as follows:

Nicklaus Flight: Index 0 to 15.9 - play from White tees. Woods Flight: Index 16.0 to 21.9 - play from White tees. Hogan Flight: Index 22.0 to 54 - play from Green tees.

Qualifying Rounds

Seeding for the Championship Rounds will be determined by the total Stableford Points accumulated by each player's 4 Best Flight Rounds. Players may play in more than the minimum Flight Cup Competitions required, however, only their 4 best flight rounds will be used to determine their place in the standings.

Championship Format

The format is individual Stroke Play. The Stableford Point scoring system will be used to determine the order of finish. Total Stableford Points for both Championship Rounds (36 Hole) will determine the winner of each Flight. The USA Stableford Tie Breaker will be in effect.

All qualified participants will have their score zeroed with the following exceptions. The highest point player in each Flight will retain 10 Stableford points, the second will retain 8, third will retain 6, fourth will retain 5, fifth will retain 4, sixth will retain 3, seventh will retain 2 and $8^{th} - 10^{th}$ retain 1 point.

*If a qualified participant withdraws from the championship finals before the first round, the Tournament Chairman will replace that player with the next qualified participant.

The LWMGC Board of Directors and the Competitions Committee use the criteria of LWMGC Cup Flight Competitions, Regular Wednesday Play and Major Tournament scores as well as past Team Play performance to narrow down the list of candidates to provide a pool that will give Laguna Woods a competitive mix of players.

The LWMGC Competition Committee also uses these team spots as a way of recognizing and rewarding these individuals for their regular support of our activities and tournaments.

Scotch Cup vs Costa Mesa Seniors


In 2005 the LWMGC began an annual Home and Away series of "Scotch Scoring" matches against the Costa Mesa Seniors Golf Club. The squads are usually made up of eight or nine 2-man teams and the total team points scored in both matches determines the annual winner. The order of the matches rotates each year, and the



the matches rotates each year, and the Scotch Cup is awarded after the final (second) match of the season.

Laguna Woods Village Cup

The Laguna Woods Village Cup has become a staple of the club's playing season. Unlike the Ryder Cup, the Laguna Woods matches would not be limited to United States versus United Kingdom players. ... but would pit 22 Club members born in the USA (Team USA) against an equal roster of 22 Club members who were born outside of the US (Team



International). The event would be a way to encourage friendly intra-club competition and give Club members a chance to play 'for their country'. The teams are broken down into 11 two-man teams which play each other head-to head in three different nine-hole match play style competitions: Alternate Shot – Better Ball – Match Play

Silver Seniors Golf League of OC

2019 was the first year of LWMGC participation in the Silver Seniors Golf League of Orange County. The teams compete with twelve players from each club, paired in six two-man teams playing a 'home and away' match with other teams in the League. Competition is a match play format. The League is divided into two divisions with a playoff at the end of the season to determine the League Champion. While there is competition between the teams, the principal objective of the League is to sponsor good sportsmanship and camaraderie.

TOURNAMENT RULES

Major Tournaments, Flight Cup, and Regular Wednesday Play

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- A. New Members are required to have read and confirm their understanding of the information within the New Member Orientation Manual. New Member Orientation meetings are held bi-monthly at the village green Rm 1. Participation in all LWMGC tournaments is restricted to LWMGC members, who are in good standing and who have a current SCGA/GHIN Handicap index as described in ARTICLE III-E of the LWMGC CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS. The maximum index limit, for scoring purposes, is 54. New members of the Men's Club who have no established handicaps will be eligible to play in Regular Wednesday Play and Major Tournaments as "Zero Index" for competition.
- B. Only those members participating in the tournament are allowed to play during scheduled tournament times. A waiver is given for the LWMGC Team events which occur during the scheduled tournament tee times.
- C. In "partner" events, the allowable handicap difference of partners will be determined by the Tournament Director.
- Scoring and Tournament rules disputes will be decided by the Tournament Director, the Handicap or Rules Committees.

- E. Play the ball as it lies, exceptions may be made at the direction of the Tournament Director on an as needed basis.
- F. LWMGC events are Medal Play tournaments. Golfers are not to accept nor offer gimmies and must sink every one of their putts, unless otherwise specified by the Tournament Director or tournament format.
- G. When temporary greens are used, a maximum of two (2) putts will be scored.
- H. The LWMGC golf tournament software program will be used to keep track of all the events each member participates in. This tracking will determine the eligibility and qualification of each member for all tournaments.
- I. When golf carts are restricted to "Cart Paths Only" on six or more holes and in the in the opinion of the Tournament Committee due to inclement or hazardous course conditions, a Major Tournament or Flight Cup event will be considered postponed (Not Canceled) and it will roll over and replace the next scheduled Regular Wednesday Play.
 - a. "Cart Path Only": If the weather conditions are favorable to play an event, every effort should be made to do so.
 - This rule does not apply to any Regular Wednesday Play
 - c. Daily course conditions are available by calling (949) 597-4373 seven days a week.

- J. Member-Member Tournament Exception: If both rounds of the Member-Member Tournament are canceled for any reason, one round will be rescheduled to be played on the next available Wednesday. The second round will not be played.
- K. Member-Member Tournament Exception: In the event of only one round being completed in the Member-Member Tournament, the results of that round will be considered the final results for the Member-Member Tournament.
- L. All players must check in at least 20 minutes prior to their tee times with the Starter, for Major Tournaments, Flight Cup, and Regular Wednesday Play. If a participant is late checking in, the Tournament Director may substitute an alternate golfer.
- M. Awards and Payment Registration for Majors, Flight Cup and Regular Wednesday Play.
 - Majors: Awards will be based on a tournament participation pool and determined by the board of directors.
 - Flight Cup Series: Awards will be based on a tournament participation pool determined by the board of directors.
 - c. Regular Wednesday Play: Hole in one payout only
- N. The Official Event scorecard must be signed by all players and must show the following information:
 - a. Individual Play Formats

- i. Last and First name of each player.
 - NOTE: To assist in Tournament scoring, the player names on the scorecard should be listed in the same order that they appear in the Online Pairings.
 - NOTE: Major tournament pairings are created by the tournament committee based on rules and format of each individual event.
- ii. Date the round was played.
- iii. Scheduled tee time for group.
- iv. The total score for each 9 and 18 holes played.

b. Team Play Formats

- Last and First name of each player.
 - NOTE: To assist in Tournament scoring, the player names on the scorecard should be listed in the same order that they appear in the Online Pairings.
 - NOTE: Major tournament pairings are created by the tournament committee based on rules and format of each individual event
- ii. Date the round was played.
- iii. Scheduled tee time for group.
- iv. Correct Team Score (as appropriate for the format) for each hole on the score card.
- v. The total score for each 9 and 18 holes played.
- vi. Other scoring information as required by the team tournament format.

O. All tournament scores of LWMGC events are posted to the GHIN System by the Tournament Director, unless otherwise specified by the Tournament Director.

P. LWMGC Club Championship

a. Flight Assignments are:

i. Club Champion - Champion Golfer of The Year - Blue Flight:

- Any club member with a current GHIIN index who has qualified may participate.
- 2. This championship competes from the SCGA blue monuments and is played to scratch with gross aggregate scoring. The LWMGC Golfer of the Year / Club Champion will be the player which shoots the lowest aggregate score over the three (3) rounds of competition.
- In the event there is not an aggregate winner after 54 holes, those players will then play a playoff at the completion of the final round.
- The Playoff will begin on Course 1 Hole 1. The playoff format will be aggregate score, per hole, in a sudden victory format for as many holes as necessary.
- If there are multiple players, the player(s) with the highest score on each hole to be eliminated

Club Champion - White Flight

Any qualified club member, (Indexes 21.8 and below), may participate. This flight will compete from the SCGA white monument.

Club Champion - Green Flight

Any qualified club member (Indexes 21.9 to 54 may participate.

This flight will compete from the SCGA green monuments.

Club Champion - Super Senior Flight:

Any qualified club member, 80 years or older as of the 1st day of the event may participate.

This flight will compete from the SCGA green monuments.

ii. Tournament Structure:

- The event will be Medal stroke play with net scoring for the White Flight, Green Flight, and Super Senior Flight. Each Flight Champion will be the player which shoots the lowest aggregate net score over the three (3) rounds of competition.
