

Day 52 - Don't Sell Your Birthright!

"Esau said, "I am about to die; of what use is a birthright to me?" Jacob said, "Swear to me now." So he swore to him and sold his birthright to Jacob. Then Jacob gave Esau bread and lentil stew, and he ate and drank and rose and went his way. Thus Esau despised his birthright." (Genesis 25:32-34)

The story of Esau and Jacob is a well known bible story in which the oldest son, Esau, out of hunger, sold his birthright to his younger brother, Jacob, for a bowl of soup. In the end, Jacob received Esau's blessing from his father, Isaac, who was blind in his old age and deceived by Jacob and his mother (Isaac's wife). In Genesis 25:34 it says, "Thus Esau despised his birthright." This act by Esau of selling his birthright angered God. In the Jewish culture at that time, the birthright gave special privileges and advantages to the first-born son which included a double portion of the father's inheritance (Deuteronomy 21:15-17).
