SECTION 1

CONDUCT & PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS

The Titleholder agrees to uphold the following standards of conduct throughout the full duration of their reign:

- 1 Titleholders shall wear their Crown, Sash, Pin, or Medallion at all functions while representing NSGSMPS.
- 2 Titleholders will conduct themselves in a professional manner at all times and will not act in any way that reflects poorly on themselves, NSGSMPS, or its board of directors.
- 3 Titleholders shall not use social media in any way that negatively represents themselves, NSGSMPS, any promoters, or any contestants running for an NSGSMPS title.
- 4 Titleholders shall not publicly speak negatively of NSGSMPS, promoters, venues, or any individual associated with NSGSMPS.
- 5 Titleholders shall not engage in malicious gossip.
- 6 Titleholders shall not engage in drug use or drug-related activities during their reign.
- 7 Titleholders shall not engage in excessive intoxication at any event at which they are representing their title or NSGSMPS.
- 8 Titleholders shall not engage in any form of prostitution.
- 9 Titleholders shall not take any photographs while wearing their Crown, Pin, or Medallion that would be used for, or result in, any form of solicitation.
- 10 Titleholders shall not compete for any other titles — including bar titles, state titles, or qualifiers for other national titles — while serving as an NSGSMPS National Titleholder.
- 11 Any criminal activity — excluding minor traffic violations — must be reported to the owners of NSGSMPS. Excessive or serious criminal activity may result in title removal, contract termination, and forfeiture of all current and future winnings.

Violations of any of the above provisions are subject to title removal at the sole discretion of the NSGSMPS Board of Directors.

SECTION 2

COMMUNICATION & REPORTING

Titleholders are required to maintain active, professional communication with NSGSMPS throughout their reign.

- Titleholders must maintain a working, valid phone number and email account for the duration of their reign.
- Titleholders must respond to all texts, messages, and emails within 48 hours.
- Titleholders are required to provide a monthly update to the owners regarding potential contestants and promoters.

Quarterly Conference Calls

All titleholders are required to attend a quarterly conference call with the Pageant Director/Owner to provide updates on their respective division. The scheduled quarters are:

Q2	February 2027
Q3	May 2027
Q4	August 2027

Planning Submissions

The following plans must be submitted to the NSGSMPS Pageant Director/Owner no later than 30 days after winning the national pageant:

- A 30/60/90-day action plan outlining your goals and activities for the first three months of your reign.
- A tentative travel plan covering scheduled appearances and preliminary dates.

SECTION 3

SOCIAL MEDIA & PROMOTION

- Titleholders are required to post on social media bi-weekly promoting National Showgirl & Showman Pageantry and their respective division. Acceptable content includes sharing promotional materials, informational posts, reels, and photos of themselves representing the brand.
- Titleholders shall make every effort to assist NSGSMPS owners and promoters in recruiting contestants, selling preliminary slots, and representing NSGSMPS community initiatives. We work as a team.
- Titleholders shall make every effort to support the continued growth of NSGSMPS through social media, networking, performances, and public speaking engagements.
- Titleholders must be actively involved in any fundraising efforts set forth by NSGSMPS (e.g., 50/50 drawings, program book sales).

SECTION 4

PRELIMINARY APPEARANCES

Titleholders agree to make themselves available for all preliminaries. The following terms govern scheduling, cancellations, and travel:

- If a titleholder is unable to attend a preliminary, they must notify the National Office, the regional promoter, and the local promoter in advance so that an alternate titleholder may be arranged. If no titleholder is available, the regional promoter or the Pageant Director / Owner may serve as a suitable substitute.
- Cancellations must be communicated to the National Office, regional promoters, and local promoters at least 14 days in advance of the preliminary date, unless due to an immediate family death or medical emergency. All other circumstances must be approved by Pageant Director / Owner.

If a titleholder cancels at the last minute or fails to appear at a confirmed preliminary, the titleholder is responsible for reimbursing the promoter for airfare, hotel, and related expenses — up to but not exceeding \$600.00, due within 48 hours after the preliminary.

- Promoters shall not be responsible for more than \$600.00 in travel costs per titleholder. If travel costs exceed this limit, the titleholder may still make the booking but must cover the difference personally.
- If a promoter fails to book a titleholder in a timely manner — causing fees to exceed the \$600.00 maximum — the promoter remains responsible for ensuring the titleholder's presence at that preliminary.

SECTION 5

AT-LARGE WEIGHT REQUIREMENT

The Titleholder for the National Showgirl At-Large division agrees to maintain the minimum weight requirement of 200 lbs. throughout the full duration of their reign. Failure to maintain this requirement may be treated as a breach of contract subject to the remedies outlined in the Contestant Waiver and this agreement.

SECTION 6

NSGSMPS OBLIGATIONS TO THE TITLEHOLDER

National Showgirl & Showman Pageantry hereby agrees to the following obligations toward the Titleholder of National Showgirl, National Showgirl At-Large, National Showgirl Supreme, and National Showman:

- NSGSMPS will ensure the titleholder is booked at all confirmed preliminaries and crowning ceremonies, unless the travel distance exceeds the \$600.00 travel limit. If a promoter requests a titleholder from another division, the titleholder will still receive their \$250 booking fee.
- NSGSMPS will assist in coordinating arrangements between the regional promoter, local promoter, and titleholder. All preliminaries must be confirmed through the main office at least 60 days prior to the event date.
- NSGSMPS will ensure the titleholder is paid all monies agreed upon by the promoter.
- NSGSMPS will pay the titleholder a booking fee of \$250.00 per appearance (unless alternative arrangements have been made), in addition to hotel and travel expenses not exceeding \$600.00 for any official event hosted by the national pageant.
- NSGSMPS will cover the titleholder's step-down event, including up to 3 nights of hotel accommodations and travel expenses not exceeding \$600.00.

SECTION 8

DEFAULT & TERMINATION

In the event the Titleholder is unable to fulfill their obligations or violates any terms of this contract, the following consequences apply:

- All remaining prize money payments will cease immediately.
- The titleholder will be required to return their Crown, Sash, Medallion, and Scepter to the NSGSMPS office at their own expense, shipped via express mail with a verifiable tracking number, in the condition originally received.
- Additional remedies as outlined in the Contestant Waiver may be applied, including but not limited to title removal, lifetime ban, and demand for return of previously paid monies.

Title removal and forfeiture of all prizes and winnings may result from any material breach of this contract, as determined solely by the NSGSMPS Board of Directors.

SECTION 9

LIABILITY RELEASE

The Titleholder agrees not to hold NSGSMPS, any associated venues, or any promoters liable for any injuries or damages sustained during their reign or in connection with any NSGSMPS event or activity.
