April 25, 2022 : Peyote Tube Earrings

Location: Wil-Mar Neighborhood Center, 504 S. Brearly St. (https://wil-mar.org/)

Date and time: MONDAY April 25th, 6:30 to 8:30, p.m. (Board meeting from 6:00-6:30)

Supplies: Delica beads (4 colors), beading thread (Nymo, Fireline (6lb), Wildfire, etc.), 2 beading needles, round-nose pliers, a pair of ear wires, 2 headpins, 4 – 4mm bicone beads, and size 8 beads (about 20 total).

At the end of this project, you should have one completed earring, learned how to read a peyote pattern, and picked up a couple of tricks for working with the peyote stitch.

Bring something for Show And Tell. I want to know the kinds of beading our members like to do...or want to learn how to do.

This is the 16th time we have displayed at the hospital. It is a chance for the society to reach out to potential new members and gives us an opportunity to sell. Display items are sold through the Hospital's gift shop (20% of sales are donated to the Hospital's art fund).

Each item needs to be accompanied by a card giving the artist's name, title or name of the piece, technique used, and the price (tax not included). If you do not want to sell a piece, write NFS in the price line. We need a value for all pieces, even those not for sale, for insurance purposes. Each item, plus card, needs to be in its own small plastic bag*, and the small plastic bags need to be in a larger plastic bag (available at Meant to Bead). This permits the exhibitor to pick and choose items for the display.

Pieces can be picked up at Meant to Bead in early June (specific date to be determined), or at the June 27th meeting. If I picked up your pieces, I can also bring them back to you. Wally pays the hospital 20% of all sales. DO NOT FORGET to reimburse her.
