Czech Star Pattern: Monday, June 26

Location: Pinney Library, 516 Cottage Grove Rd.

Time: 6:30 to 8:30, p.m. (Board meeting from 6:00-6:30)

Supplies: (For one star) 20 SuperDuos, 15 0 beads, 5 size 11 seed beads; Plus beading needle, Fireline beading thread (pattern calls for 4lb but I think 6lb will work too), scissors, and bead mat

Okay, I confess, I'm on a bit of a SuperDuo kick right now. In my defense, I have a lot of SuperDuos so I'm always looking for SuperDuo projects so I can use them up. I also have some O beads ... leftover from a project or for a project I forgot about. The pattern works up fast. Make two and you have a pair of earrings. Make more and string them together for a bracelet or necklace. And if you like this pattern, I have more star/snowflake patters that call for SuperDuos (maybe for the November meeting, hint hint).

I'll bring kits of the beads, enough to make 2 stars (I have plenty of SuperDuo, seed, and 0 beads), but you need to bring your own bead thread and needle.
