### **You will need:**

Size 10 seed beads

6mm round beads (6)

Size 3 bugle beads (18)\*

0.3 mm (26 gauge) wire

\*Using larger bugles is okay; you'll just have longer spokes.

Back to one of my favorite beads, superduos. These are small enough for earrings or make several and connect them to make a bracelet.



### **You will need:**

Superduo beads (1 or 2 colors) [for purposes of this meeting, please don't bring mini Superduos]

Size 11 seed beads

Size 6 seed beads (the instructions say size 5 seed beads, but I've never seen size 5 seed beads)

Size 6 Fireline

Beading needle, scissors, bead mat
