Leo Brouwer - *The Rhythm of the Night Changed*

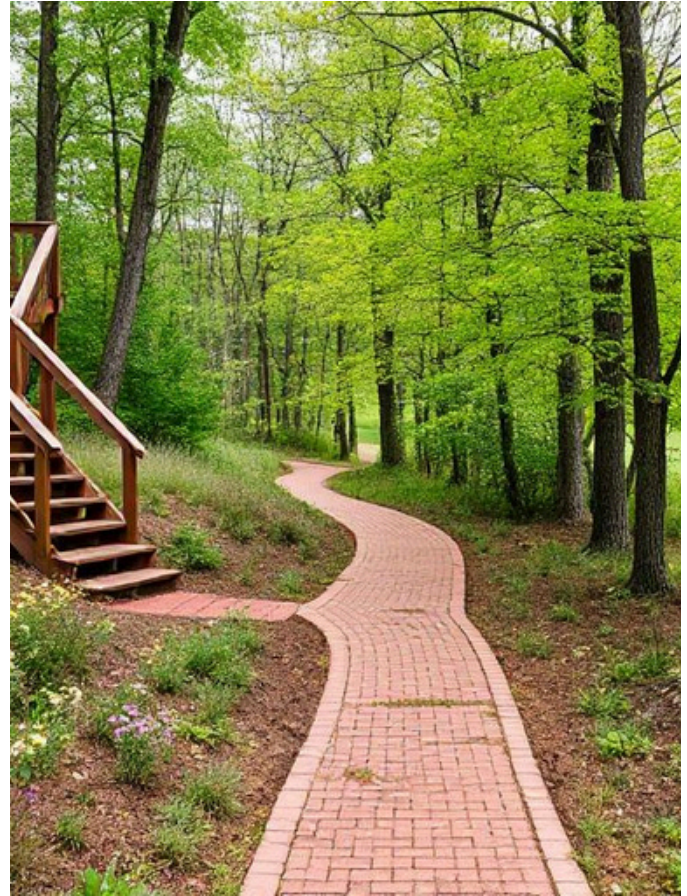
