




Everyone knows someone who has been affected by cancer. The SwampBats invite the public to their Pink in the Park Night to honor the cancer survivors in our community!

- Heat oven to 400 degrees
- ½ cup of soft shortening (part butter)
- 1 cup sugar

- 1 tsp vanilla
- 1 ¾ cup flour
- ½ tsp salt
- ½ tsp baking soda
- 1 cup chopped pecans
