Monadnock Originals: Local Tales and Characters 1:15 pm, Thursday, November 13, at The Keene Senior Center

Learn more about the history of our region through the eyes of local historian and author Alan F. Rumrill. He will present stories that reveal a region defined by its Yankee character and filled with Yankee characters. The Monadnock Region has often been referred to as New Hampshire's "forgotten corner."

It is a quiet region known for its historic New England villages and beautiful natural landscape. Overlooked tales from the past prove that this has not always been a quiet place.

Noteworthy inventors, outspoken women, military heroes, nationally prominent businessmen and dastardly criminals all called the region home.





Alan F. Rumrill has been a significant figure in the preservation and sharing of the history of the southwestern corner of New Hampshire. As the executive director of the Historical Society of Cheshire County, he led the organization through a period of impressive growth. Currently semiretired, he stays active as the Senior Historian at HSCC.






Healthy Bones for Life 1:00 pm, Thursday, November 6, via Zoom at the Center
