Wishing you peace and joy during this holiday season!



What is Kwanza?

According to the National Museum of African American History and Culture, "Kwanzaa is a time for families and communities to come together to remember the past and to celebrate African American

culture.



Created in 1966 by Maulana Ron Karenga, Kwanzaa is an African American and Pan-African holiday that celebrates history, values, family, community and culture. The ideas and concepts of Kwanzaa are expressed in the Swahili language, one of the most widely spoken languages in Africa.

Kwanzaa gets its n'me from the Swahili phrase, 'matunda ya kwanza" and is rooted in first fruit celebrations which are found in cultures throughout Africa both in ancient and modern times.

The seven principles which form its core were drawn from communitarian values found throughout the African continent. "

The celebration lasts 7 days. Each day is focused on a Swahili principle:

- Day One: Umoja (Unity)
- Day Two: Kujichagulia (Self-Determination)
- Day Three: Ujima (Collective Work and Responsibility)
- Day Four, Ujamaa (Cooperative Economics)
- Day Five: Nia (Purpose)
- Day Six: Kuumba (Creativity)
- Day Seven: Imani (Faith)

This year the holiday celebration starts on December 26, the day after Christmas. One candle is lit each day until all seven are lit on the last day.

New Hampshire Kwanzaa celebrations are being held at various NH colleges and community centers around the state.



Chocolate Drop Quickies

A quick sweet treat. No baking needed. Just cook and drop on wax or parchment paper.

Ingredients

2 cups sugar
½ cup butter
½ cup cocoa
½ cup milk
3 cups quick-cooking rolled oats
½ cup chopped nuts
1 tsp vanilla extract



Instructions

- Mix sugar, butter, cocoa and milk in a saucepan.
- Bring to boil quickly, reduce heat to medium and boil for 3 or 4 mins.
- Remove from heat, stir in rolled oats, nuts and by teaspoonfuls drop onto waxed or parchment paper.
- Let stand until hardened.
- Store in the refrigerator.

Makes about 3 dozen cookies.
