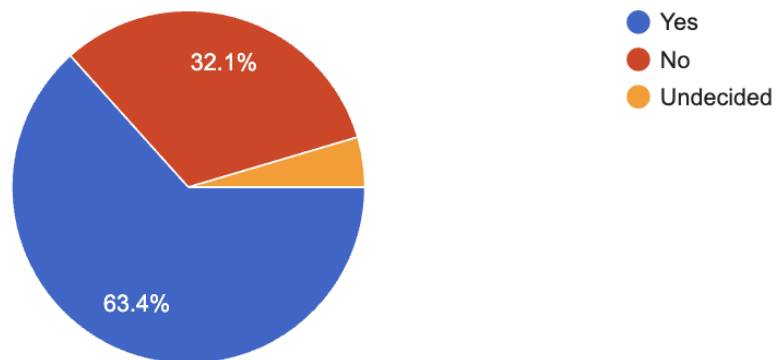


1. Nosebands

USEF Rule GR839 prohibits the use of “Augmented Nosebands. Any noseband with an interior that is abrasive is prohibited, except nosebands made of rope or rawhide.” A noseband with a flat, smooth chain interior is currently considered an “augmented noseband” under GR839 and is prohibited.

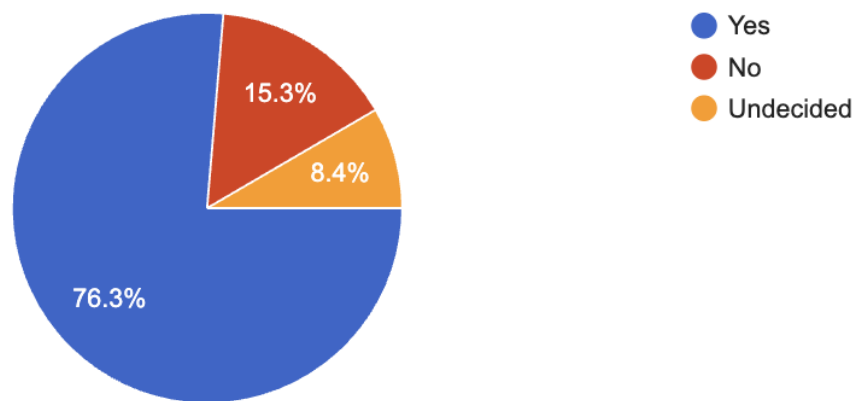


2. Foam Rails

Currently, **foam rails are not permitted** in the schooling area for equitation classes (USEF Rule **EQ114 / JP Appendix A**).

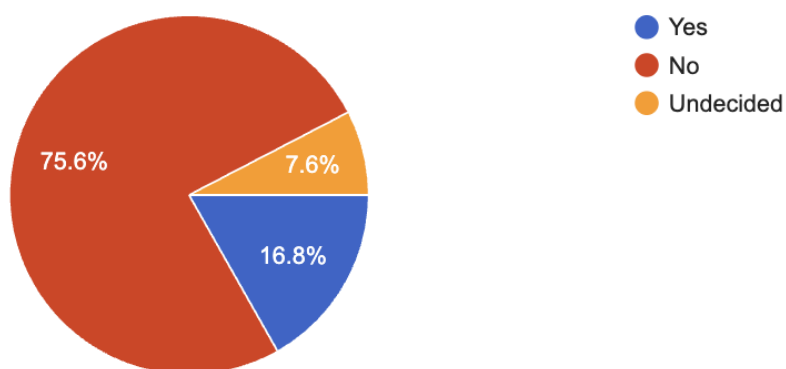


3. Prize Money in Equitation
