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# Step 1:

#### Meet the Eligibility Requirements:

To be eligible for a CDA credential, you need to have a high school diploma or GED, be at least 18 years old and have 480 hours of experience working with children within the last five years.

LET'S BREAK IT DOWN:

480 ÷ 8 hrs a day = 60 working days

60 ÷ 20 Days a month

=3 months

#### Choose a Setting & Purchase your Book:

<u>In which you want to specialize:</u> infant/toddler, preschool, or family child care and home vistor.

Order the CDA Competency Standards Book for \$28-\$30 from the CDA Council website.



# CDA Candidates Requirements

Candidates applying for the CDA Credential must be observed working in a "setting" that meets the following:

Candidates may be employed or volunteer in a childcare setting.

#### Preschool Candidates:

A Preschool Center-Based setting is a state-approved child development center where a CDA candidate can be observed working with a group of at **least 8 children**, all of whom are ages 3 to 5 years.

In addition, the center-based program must have:
At least 10 children enrolled in the program enrolled in the center.
At least 2 teachers working with children on a regular basis.
Infant Toddler Candidates
Infant Toddler candidates can be observed working with a group of at <b>least 3 children between</b> the ages of birth through 36 months. A candidate may work with all subgroups or one subgroup.
In addition, the center-based program must have:
At least 10 children enrolled in the program enrolled in the center.
At least 2 teachers working with children on a regular basis.

#### Candidates Must:

#### High School Diploma/GED

You must have a valid High School diploma or GED. Candidates currently enrolled as a junior or senior in a high school or technical program in early childhood education are acceptable.

#### Literacy Skills

Must be able to speak, read and write well enough in the language required at work, to fulfill the responsibilities of applying for the CDA.

# Step 3:

#### Enroll & Complete a CDA Training course.

Complete the required child development training, which involves: safety, health, and nutrition training classes.

The training must include **120 clock hours** of formal education, which can be completed through a variety of options, including online courses, self-paced online courses, workshops, and college programs.



Depending on the format, the CDA Training cost will be around \$250-450.

Check your state and employer for CDA Scholarships to cover all or some costs.

Step 4: Create an account with YourCouncil.



# Step 5: Complete your CDA Portfolio!

While you are working on CDA Training, this can be a perfect time to start working on your CDA Portfolio, which may take a while to prepare.


# Step 5:

#### Preparing Your CDA Portfolio Consists of:

Prepare your CDA Portfolio by collecting documentation and writing reflective statements that demonstrate your competence in each of the CDA competency standards.

#### Required Documentation

- "My CDA Professional Portfolio" Cover Sheet
- Summary Of My CDA Education and other transcripts/ certificates.
- Family Questionnaires
- Reflective Competency Statements I-VI
- Resource Collection Items
- Professional Philosophy Statment



# Step 6:

Submit the application and \$425 assessment fee. (Check your state's early learning department for CDA Scholarship Awards to cover expenses). Follow the requirements and submit the document forms requested.

- a. Select your Professional Development Specialist (PDS) who is certified in your credential area and record their identification number on your application.
- b. Email them to introduce yourself and set up a date and time for your observation.

DON'T FORGET TO ALERT YOUR DIRECTOR AND COWORKERS AT LEAST 2 WEEKS BEFORE THE VERIFICATION VISIT DAY.

### Day Before Verification Visit & Day Of

- Alert staff and director two weeks before, a week, and 2 days before visit and time.
- Print out and bring CDA Portfolio, and place it inside the binder.
- Bring CDA Book
- Follow state Child Care regulations and use previous training to run the classroom.
- Pretend nobody is watching!
- Be prepared to be watched for 4-8 hours and ask for a teacher's assistant.
- Have activities printed and ready the day before.






