I wondered why the queue was so long and didn't seem to move. I said "I don't pay to see Buddha!" And then, with that, two large wooden doors opened beside me and I walked straight into a garden through those doors. The garden was beautiful and very bright in colour, it was a wonderful experience just to walk into it. There sat — in his usual cross legged pose — the Buddha Himself. That pose is known as 'Mudra' was something that he would explain later to me. For now, I asked him why I was here? He said "simply because you saw the Truth". He was smiling and it was intoxicating. He spoke quietly, so quietly that I had to focus very much to hear Him. He said to me that I was to sit in Mudra with him to understand Mudra.

The conversation led to me looking out over the view that he was sitting looking upon. It was a village below that was a quiet and small village.
