## GOD HAS A PLAN FOR YOUR LIFE

"The Lord God placed the man in the Garden of Eden as its gardener, to tend and care for it..."

## Genesis 2:15-23 (TLB).

Before God created man, He first created the world he would live in. Before He placed man in Eden, He already planted the garden with various trees and supplied it with rivers. In your purpose lies all you will ever need to be fulfilled in life; outside this, struggling is inevitable.

However, God also gave Adam a 'warning for living'; and this is true of you as well. In fulfilling your purpose, there are things you must not do and there are things you may do. One thing you must not be found doing as a purpose – conscious person is SINNING. This can cost you your fulfillment in life.

So, be born of God, discover your purpose, start working and walking in line with your purpose, obey all the warnings you are given by your Maker (as contained in the Bible), and all you will ever need to be fulfilled in life will be made available to you. You won't have to pray at times before your needs are met. May your life here on earth cooperate with God's plan for you. Amen.
